After a run of five games out of six away from home, this afternoon is the middle fixture in a run of three successive home games. After next Wednesday at home v Montrose, we only have visits from Bathgate and Kinnoull to complete our home season.

Today however, we welcome the players, officials and supporters of Broughty Athletic to Canniepairt for yet another game which can be accurately described as 'crucial' in our bid to return to the top echelon of the Junior game.

Despite being one of our near neighbours, games against Broughty on the Canniepairt have been fairly sparse over the years and this afternoon is only the seventh in the past decade. We won by the handsome margin of 8-0 back in August 2006 and by 5-0 in the most recent encounter here in a Premier League fixture in 2012 but in the four games in between, Broughty definitely held the upper hand, with two 1-1 draws and two 1-0 wins in an unbeaten run at Canniepairt from 2008 to 2011.

In recent times Broughty have demonstrated their aim to take a place amongst the leading Junior clubs in the area under the stewardship of current club chairman and treasurer Gordon Deuchars, the managing director of GA Engineering (Scotland) Ltd. Despite the recruitment of a number of seasoned ex-Seniors such as Jamie McCunnie (Dundee United, Dunfermline), Dougie Cameron (Dundee, East Fife), Jamie Winter (Aberdeen, Chesterfield, Montrose) and Lee Sibanda (Arbroath). In addition the visitors' pool contains two former Tayport players who have sampled the Seniors, goalkeeper Iain Ross (East Fife) and Bryan Duell (Forfar Athletic).

The investment wasn't delivering as planned under manager Ian McKenna and he stepped down earlier this season. 34 year old Keith Gibson, who had a handful of games for Tayport last season on loan from Forfar Athletic, moved from the Whitton Park dressing room to the manager's office to kick off his managerial career. Keith brought in the vastly experienced Ray Farningham as his assistant, a role Ray had previously undertaken at Dundee FC. Also joining the backroom staff was Tony McAuley, who will be remembered from his days with St Josephs.

Broughty were tipped to mount a late challenge for promotion but some indifferent performances have seen their efforts stall somewhat. With the personnel at their disposal Broughty are clearly capable of matching the best on their day and a play off place at least, is still within their sights.

Tayport had to battle hard to win the three points v Glenrothes on Wednesday and today's line up will show changes as Stef Elvin and Ryan Suttie are unavailable but it is hoped Gary Sutherland has recovered from the illness which caused him to miss Wednesday's 2-1 win over Glens.

Dunmore Reports.....



What a month it's been! A hectic spell of fixtures is now upon us, but April has proved to be a successful month for the club, with five competitive wins in a row.

The month began with a visit by Jeanfield Swifts, on league duty. The Perth side opened the scoring, but a sensational strike from Grant Lawson gave Tayport an equaliser. Shortly afterwards, a fine Alan Tulleth free kick edged the Canniepairt outfit into the lead. Into the second half, a glancing Kevin Milne header stretched the advantage, only for Jeanfield to reduce the deficit, through Jayson Alexander. Next up was a semi-final at Blairgowrie, in the GA Engineering Cup. This match proved to be a more straightforward affair and was essentially a case of one-way traffic. Kevin Milne helped himself to a hat-trick, while Gary Sutherland, Kris Rollo and Stefan Elvin, from the spot, were the other marksmen in a comprehensive 6-1 rout. Kit Bremner headed Blair's consolation goal, for what was the only blip of the afternoon.

It was back to league business that midweek, with a trip to Strathmore Park, to play Forfar West End. 'Port got off to a great start, with Paul Thomson powering home a header, from Alan Tulleth's corner, five minutes into the match. It proved to be the only goal of the game, as West End, as usual, were stubborn opponents.

The win set Tayport up for last Saturday's north-east Fife derby at St. Andrews. It was very much a top of the table clash and 'Port came out very much on top. Clark Kay opened the scoring and the visitors led at the break. Jamie Mackie snatched an equaliser at the start of the second half, but then Tayport took command. The tenacious Kevin Milne lobbed 'Port into the lead, then headed a third goal, from a Tulleth cross. Late in the game, Grant Lawson netted a penalty to make it 4-1, with Jamie Mackie ordered off for his display of petulance in the aftermath of the goal.

The result saw Tayport leapfrog the Saints, into top spot and Dave Baikie's men maintained their position on Wednesday night, when Glenrothes were beaten 2-1 in another Fife derby. Scott Napier volleyed the Glens into an early lead, but Kevin Milne levelled, after an intervention by Grant Lawson. Milne scored again midway through the half when he latched onto a Stefan Elvin pass and finished in style, for his eighth goal of a very productive month so far.
