Well, this is it. The climax to what's been a roller coaster season. An indifferent start with two wins from the first six games followed by five wins on the bounce to keep in touch at the top. A less than cheerful festive period with successive 0-2 home defeats either side of New Year followed by a number of postponements made for a gloomy start to 2015.

Everything changed, though, at Bathgate on Valentine's day when we embarked on a run of eight successive wins. Although we were playing catch-up heading into the home straight, everything looked rosy until we suffered another hiccup and four successive games yielded only one point, culminating in losing a 3-2 after leading 2-0 at Edinburgh United.

The gloom was dispelled at Tannadice and the GA Cup win was the springboard for three impressive performances which delivered three league victories in six days. St Andrews United losing at home to North End was the icing on that week's cake and the 4-1 win at North End this week confirmed that Tayport as Premier champions.

Whilst we've been looking upwards, our opponents today have been looking over their shoulders in the opposite direction as relegation to the South Division looms large. It's Bathgate's last game of the season this afternoon and the bottom line is that they must take something from the game to maintain their hopes of avoiding the drop. A point would take Thistle above Glenrothes but it's pretty imperative to get a win which would make it more difficult for Forfar West End and North End who are playing catch up.

The halcyon days of two Scottish Cup final appearances, losing in 2006 but lifting the Holy Grail in 2008, are now but very pleasant memories for Bathgate fans who have seen their side play in the second tier since relegation from the Super League on goal difference in 2012.

When manager Barrie Malcolm, formerly, the SFA's Development Officer in Fife, took over at Nursery Park, his intention was to "play entertaining football. A neat, passing possession game. I want the fans to know when they come to our games they'll be entertained and watch a good footballing team", he said. Although they find themselves in trouble, it's fair to say that Bathgate haven't been far away from picking up far more points and since the turn of the year have had three wins, five draws and of their five defeats, three have been by the odd goal. Turn three draws into wins and they'd be sitting comfortably mid table.

An exciting contest is in prospect.

Following this afternoon's final whistle Tayport will be presented with the Championship trophy.

The Scottish Junior Cup final takes place at Rugby Park, Kilmarnock on Sunday 7 June between Musselburgh Athletic and Auchinleck Talbot. It's a repeat of the 2011 Final which Talbot won 2-1. Auchinleck, the favourites, are playing in their 7th final of the new century. Incidentally Tayport still lie in third place with 3 final appearances in the naughties, 2 behind Linlithgow Rose.

Haddington Athletic are the South Division champions and they will be joined by runners up Falkirk in a step up to the Premier.

In the DJ Laing East of Scotland Cup the final is between Bo'ness United who beat Jeanfield 1-0 in last Monday's semi final and Hill of Beath who defeated Carnoustie 4 -2 in Wednesday's other semi final.

Camelon played Bo'ness last night in the first Fife & Lothians semi final and the other, featuring Sauchie and Linlithgow, goes ahead on Monday.

Tayport lifted the other Regional Cup, the GA Engineering Cup, at Tannadice the other night v North End and in so doing increased the number of times we've lifted this cup to eight. Not bad, considering this season was the first we've entered the competition since 2005.



Not just a managerial merry go round in Dundee Junior circles. Phil Hart, erstwhile secretary of Downfield, has been appointed secretary at North End. Phil left Downfield following the news breaking of the situation which has led to Downfield being heavily fined and deducted 15 points by the ERSJFA, allegedly for an administrative error whereby they unwittingly fielded a player in five league games who had not been reinstated to Junior status after having played for a Senior club. This is basically a box ticking exercise which costs the Junior club £40 per reinstatement but one where clubs have fallen foul before and been fined and deducted points. Downfield have appealed the decision of the ERSJFA and this appeal will be heard by the Scottish Junior FA next Tuesday. As things stand, the points deduction sees Downfield miss out on the North Division title and, what's worse, promotion to the Premier level.



Dunmore Reports.....



It's been a rollercoaster ride over the past month! At the time of the last edition of the Port Prog. Tayport had gone top of the league on goal difference, with two games in hand and everything in the garden was looking rosy. Suddenly, four matches without a win changed the whole outlook and Port were in fourth place. eight points adrift of a promotion slot. First up, the emerging Broughty Athletic brought Tayport's winning run to an end, with a 1-0 victory on the Canniepairt. Dave Baikie's men then drew a second successive blank when they were held to a goalless draw by visiting Montrose Roselea, in a midweek fixture. The lack of goals scored was rectified away to Arniston Rangers, where the opposition's net bulged three times, only for Tayport to lose four goals and another three points. having twice led. Alan Tulleth netted a brace in the first half, with Arnie also scoring twice in the opening 45 minutes. A wonderful goal from Grant Lawson edged the visitors back in front, but another two Arniston goals saw them take the points. There was a similar story at Edinburgh United the following Saturday. Gary Sutherland and Alan Tulleth had Tayport cruising, with no shortage of chances coming their way. Edinburgh pulled one back early in the second half and a late collapse saw three points slip from Tayport's grasp. It was perhaps for the best that the next match was the cup final at Tannadice. On Friday 15th May, the team rose to the challenge and lifted the inter-regional GA Engineering Cup. Dale Robertson opened the scoring and Stefan Elvin fired in a second, two minutes into the second half. Gary Sutherland added a third, before North End pulled a goal back. Grant Lawson completed the scoring in injury-time and went on to lift Tayport's first silverware for six years. That triumph galvanised the troops for the promotion push. Within five days, both Jeanfield Swifts and Kinnoull had been swept aside by four goal wins. Stefan Elvin, Ryan Suttie, Grant Lawson and Garv Sutherland were on the mark against Swifts, while Lawson, Clark Kay, Sutherland and Elvin saw off Kinnoull on the Canniepairt.

Now, Tayport were one win from promotion, with a tough trip to Oakley on the cards. Kevin Milne set up Grant Lawson for the opener, but Oakley levelled from the spot. Tayport dug deep, however, and a thumping Clark Kay (right) header proved to be the winner, sparking scenes of jubilation on and off the park. Just as promotion was



being celebrated, news filtered through that St. Andrews United had lost their last game of the season, leaving Tayport on the brink of the title. (*Continued Over*)

So, to Wednesday night, when Tayport made their title win official by replicating the GA cup final score in defeating Dundee North End by four goals to one. The Dokens had a couple of early opportunities, but failed to convert and it was 'Port who opened the scoring, on 21 minutes, when Stefan Elvin forced his way into the penalty area to find the net.

North End, desperate for a win themselves, equalised on the half hour though, when Scott McComiskie beat Gavin Wilson with a back-post header.

Two quickfire goals in the second half turned the match in Tayport's favour. On 57 minutes, Dale Robertson did well on the left and sent over a perfect cross for Connaire Connelly (right), who powered home a fine header to give his side the lead. Within a minute, Clark Kay's pass found Grant Lawson and he raced away to touch the ball past 'keeper Mackie, into the corner of the net, to make it 3-1.



The win was sealed in injury-time, with Gary Sutherland coming off the bench to head home Tayport's fourth, from a Ruaridh Donaldson corner.

68 YEARS AGO -----

Tayport FC as we know it today split from Tayport Violet, also members of the Midlands AFA, in 1947.

The first Tayport FC committee was formed at a meeting on 18 June 1947. Elected were

President - F. Wighton snr.

Vice President - WA Hughes snr.

Secretary - I Hill

Treasurer - I McDonald

Committee - J.Dickson, A.Westwater, F.Wighton inr, W.Hughes inr and J.Rae.

The Courier reported on Wednesday 21 May 1947 that the Final of the Midlands AFA's Bremner Cup between RAF Leuchars and YM Anchorage would be played at Tayport after Tayport Violet had granted the use of their ground. It was noted that RAF were the holders, the cup having been held over during the war years.

[RAF Leuchars, YM Anchorage and Tayport Violet have all now passed into history but the Mdlands AFA's premier cup competition, the Bremner Cup continues to be contested. Indeed earlier this week in the 2015 final NCR AFC defeated St James FC at Tannadice Park after Dundee United had granted use of their ground. Some contrast. The Courier also reported that "Tayport Violet FC would be losing the services of energetic secretary George Lonie who had received an appointment in India and is leaving early June"
