Harthill Royal A Brief History



Harthill Royal are making their first ever visit to Tayport this afternoon. Indeed the sides have only ever met on one previous occasion, a Scottish Cup 1st round tie four years ago at Gibbshill Park, Harthill.

Harthill Royal started life in the East Region Juniors in 1992, two years after Tayport joined up, having previously been amateur and taking their name from Harthill's Royal Bar. The Bar bit was dropped on joining the Juniors.

The East Region at that time comprised of two divisions, primarily Lothians and Falkirk District clubs. Off the field in 1993, Bathgate's Creamery Park had just been totally refurbished and Linlithgow Rose had completed concrete terracing on three sides of their Prestonfield ground.

When Harthill made their debut in August 1992, three teams no longer in the Juniors were playing in the East Region Juniors. Ormiston Primrose and Preston Athletic now play in the East of Scotland League and Lowland League respectively whilst Bonnybridge have been defunct for some years now.

Fauldhouse United would be division one champions that season whilst the fledgling Harthill Royal took the second division by storm to take the championship, veteran striker Pat Daly netting the only goal in a 1-0 win over Pumpherston to clinch the title and give the Royal Bar's profits a considerable boost.

The stay in the top tier was short and Harthill were promptly relegated the following season. They bounced back immediately, again as champions, and in 1996 finished in their best ever league placing - 9th in division one. It was to be only one season in the top tier, however, before dropping down again.

The yoyo club reputation continued and another championship followed with, on cue, relegation following. Since winning the Lothians division two title in the restructured 2002/03 season, it's been a struggle for Harthill. In the past five seasons, Harthill have finished 3rd bottom, 2nd bottom and bottom of the South Division on three occasions. They can take heart, however, from the fact that the team that finished below them when finishing 2nd bottom two seasons ago, Edinburgh United, went on to take the title the following season and were our guests here at the Canniepairt three weeks ago.

Second viewing of Tayport in four days and for the second time a five goals match. It was a good game, the United side looked young but they were big lads and skilful and certainly a match for a Tayport side somewhat changed from Saturday's game. The U20 side took the lead twice but Tayport turned things round in the last 15 minutes as the youngsters began to tire. Until then their superior organisation had caused the home side plenty of problems when attacking. Canniepart is a nice small ground located in the southern part of Tayport, a pleasant small town easily reached by bus from Dundee. DISGRACEFUL SCENES AT TAYPORT

FREE FIGHTS AMONG PLAYERS

Tayport met Thornton Rovers for a second time this season at Tayport in the first round of the East of Scotland Cup. It will be remembered that Thornton protested against the field not being properly fenced in. Thornton with the wind, kicked off. Half time ended 1-0 in favour of Tayport.

In the second half Hill scored a beauty. Brown kicked Hill, who quarrelled with him, and in half a minute the players were fighting amongst themselves for all they were worth.

Roughead, after the game was started, kicked A. Rae and then flew at W. Oswald and the game was stopped for a second time. Tayport were awarded a second penalty for one of Thornton's players kicking an opponent, but A. Oswald kicked over.


