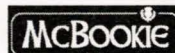

The Wizard of the Dribble's generation didn't frown on smoking as long as it wasn't actually *on* the field, as shown by this football reporter's remarks (taken from an old Essex newspaper): "I am not anti-tobacconist, but I do not think it is at all good form for a goalkeeper to be seen smoking a cigarette in goal while the game is in progress, and for a linesman to be seen smoking a pipe. Yet both incidents occurred on Saturday at Ilford."

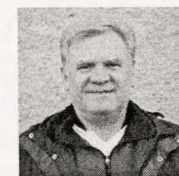

# Dundee North End

## A Brief History



Dundee North End Football Club were formed in 1895 and nicknamed the Dokens, they play their home games at North End Park which has room for around 2,000 spectators and is within the vicinity of the grounds of both Dundee and Dundee United. Their colours are maroon and white.

Dundee North End were one of the better junior teams in the Tayside region, but have found it tougher in the East Region, of which they, along with all Tayside clubs, became a part in 2002.

### Notable former players

The following players each played in a professional league either before or after their time at the club:

**Iain Jenkins** - Jenkins began his career with Everton and made five league appearances for the Toffees. After a short loan spell at Bradford City, Jenkins moved to Chester City, where he would stay with the Blues five years. He recovered from a car accident in November 1995 to play again within five months and went on to often captain the side before leaving for Dundee United in March 1998. By this point, Jenkins was part of the Northern Ireland squad.



**Hamish McAlpine** - McAlpine joined Dundee United from North End in 1966, and after spending a season on loan to Montrose made his first team debut for the Tannadice club in March 1969. By 1974 he had established himself as the club's undisputed first choice goalkeeper, a position he would retain for the next decade. McAlpine's eccentricities made him very much a cult favourite at Tannadice.



**Gordon Smith** - Smith showed great footballing promise playing for Montrose Roselea and Dundee North End. Smith pursued a career as a professional with Hibernian. Smith soon established himself as an idol for a whole generation of post-war football fans. Smith played against Hearts on his debut, scoring a hat-trick in a 5-3 victory on 28 April 1941.



Alongside Bobby Johnstone, Lawrie Reilly, Eddie Turnbull, and Willie Ormond, Smith became part of the "Famous Five", the most celebrated forward line in Hibs' history.

Smith signed for Dundee and forming a part of their league-winning side in 1962.

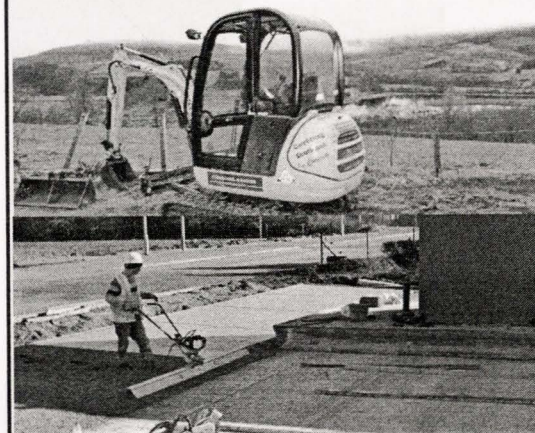
During his playing career, Gordon Smith was capped 19 times by Scotland, scoring four goals. Smith was compared with his English contemporaries Stanley Matthews and Tom Finney.

# Dunmore Reports.....



It's been a frustrating few weeks for Tayport, since the narrow win in the Fife derby against Glenrothes.

Three weeks ago, it was probably a case of two points dropped, when Dalkeith Thistle came to town. In a fairly uneventful first half, the visitors cashed in on a defensive lapse to open the scoring, with David Morris finding the net.

'Port moved up a gear after the break and created a couple of openings before levelling matters on 61 minutes. Gary Sutherland connected with a deep cross to the far post and the ball struck a defender on its way into the net.

Sutherland was also instrumental a couple of minutes later, as Tayport took the lead. He controlled the ball inside the area and expertly lofted it goal wards. As the ball entered the net, various players attempted to make contact, Kevin Milne amongst them. The important thing was that the Canniepairt outfit were ahead and on track for a third consecutive league win.

Unfortunately, Dalkeith left with a point, after a 74th minute equaliser. Tayport gave away a free kick in a dangerous position and Steven Pudleski curled home the set-piece. There were few chances in the closing stages and the game ended all-square, with Thistle likely to have been more satisfied with their point.

A fortnight ago, 'Port were denied the chance to get back to winning ways when the East of Scotland Cup tie at home to Harthill Athletic was cancelled, as Harthill could not raise a team. A most disappointing situation.

That midweek, Tayport did have a morale-boosting win against Montrose F.C. In a friendly at Links Park. Stefan Elvin and Grant Lawson, from the spot, netted in a 2-1 victory.

It was a different story against Montrose Roselea on Saturday, with three points dropped at Broomfield Park. The hosts scored once in each half and that proved to be enough to notch the win. Tayport created quite a few half-chances, but could not find the net and the game ended with Stefan Elvin being dismissed, for a second bookable offence. It was an afternoon to forget.

Still, the division is turning out to be a tight one, with only five points separating the top twelve. A positive result today would likely see Dave Baiki's men climb a few places and hopefully get closer to the early pace-setters.

Second viewing of Tayport in four days and for the second time a five goals match. It was a good game, the United side looked young but they were big lads and skilful and certainly a match for a Tayport side somewhat changed from Saturday's game. The U20 side took the lead twice but Tayport turned things round in the last 15 minutes as the youngsters began to tire. Until then their superior organisation had caused the home side plenty of problems when attacking. Both sides played some neat passing football but the U20 side lacked some penetration to make their possession pay.

Canniepart is a nice small ground located in the southern part of Tayport, a pleasant small town easily reached by bus from Dundee. The ground is dominated by a spacious and sturdy enclosure with five shallow steps to the right of the entrance. To the left is the two-storey dressing room block with refreshments served through a hatch at the end of the building, hot dogs, burgers, steak and mince pies were dished out tonight. Apart from the enclosure, the ground is fairly basic with grass banks at the near end and far side. The far end has a hedge right behind the goal and is out of bounds for spectators. From the highest step in the enclosure you have a grand view across Tay to Broughty castle. Good evening!

Tayport met Thornton Rovers for a second time this season at Tayport in the first round of the East of Scotland Cup. It will be remembered that Thornton protested against the field not being properly fenced in. Thornton with the wind, kicked off. Half time ended 1-0 in favour of Tayport.

In the second half Hill scored a beauty. Brown kicked Hill, who quarrelled with him, and in half a minute the players were fighting amongst themselves for all they were worth.

Roughead, after the game was started, kicked A. Rae and then flew at W. Oswald and the game was stopped for a second time. Tayport were awarded a second penalty for one of Thornton's players kicking an opponent, but A. Oswald kicked over.

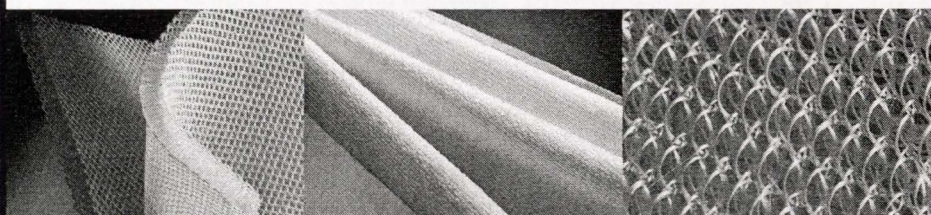
