Tayport v Bonnyrigg Rose

We welcome Bonnyrigg Rose today for their tenth visit to the Canniepairt - but the first time for a cup tie. Like Tayport, Bonnyrigg were drawn against North League opposition in round one and won through to today's tie with a 2-1 home win over Inverness City.

Bonnyrigg had a disappointing start to their Super League season, suffering 4 defeats in their first 5 games, a run which prompted the resignation of team boss Max Christie. Into the hot seat stepped experienced campaigner David McGlynn.

McGlynn is assisted by veteran player/coach Steven Hislop (pictured) who was appointed by the previous managerial regime after a lengthy senior career embracing seven clubs for whom he was always a prolific scorer. After leaving East Fife two seasons ago, Hislop moved to Bo'ness United for whom he played here last season.



The new Bonnyrigg boss freshened things up and arrives in Tayport today with his team on the back of a seven game unbeaten run. Sitting comfortably in mid table despite their poor start, Bonnyrigg will be looking to give their season a boost and avoid repeating the early exit they made from last season's national competition.

The Tayport squad has been handicapped for what seems like months now, through a series of injuries and holiday absences but, apart from a few niggles, most are fit and the manager should have a larger pool from which to select today's team. Neil Docherty missed out through injury last week but should be available however it's probably a bit early for Matty Adam, still recovering from the injury sustained v Edinburgh United.

JOE KIMMET... GROUNDHOPPER EXTRAORDINAIRE

Joe, Tayport FC's catering supremo, has travelled the length and breadth of the United Kingdom on Football Groundhops but his most recent Groundhop trip was his most adventurous yet.

Said Joe, "the fact that my Friday plane from Edinburgh to Stansted was 2 hours late in leaving should perhaps have been an early indication of how my recent trip to the Suffolk Groundhop might go. "I eventually booked into my B&B in Ipswich before travelling to the evening match featuring Felixstowe v Hadleigh. It was fine and bright when I went into the clubhouse for something to eat but at 7.40pm the ground was enshrouded in fog and five minutes later the match ref arrived and promptly called the game off. "It was a big loss of revenue for the home club with the arrival of the Groundhop contingent set to swell the average 'gate' by about 300%.

"So I did what folk do when a match has been called off at the last minute, I adjourned to the pub with several fellow Groundhoppers and there I arranged lifts to the three Saturday games which we were to take in at Woodbridge Town, Ipswich Wanderers and Brantham Athletic.

"I had only managed to book B&B for one night and when someone in the pub mentioned I would get B&B on the overnight ferry from Harwich to the Hook of Holland at knock down price, I thought, mmm... why not, after first checking out that I could take in a couple of games on Sunday in Holland.

"On arrival in Holland I caught the train from Rotterdam to Almelo for the derby game between Heracles and FC Twente. "A good game it was, too, but with little or no public transport in Holland on a Sunday, I struggled to get back to the station in time to take in another game. "Worse was to follow, though, when I discovered the overnight ferry to Harwich was fully booked [memo to myself...must buy return tickets in future].

"Plan B. Take the train from Rotterdam to Brussels and catch Monday morning's Eurostar to London in time to catch my plane from Stansted to Edinburgh. "Unfortunately first train was fully booked and second train would be too late to catch my flight.

"It would have to be Plan C - so I took the TGV train to Paris to catch a connection to Calais. Sounded ok but on arrival in Paris, I discovered I had missed the last train to Calais. Merde!

"The Eurostar was packed out with pinstripe suits poring over laptops so you can imagine an un-showered groundhopper in jeans and t-shirt with three days growth received a few strange looks.

"All went smoothly after that however, arriving at St Pancras at 8.30 in time for the train to Stansted and the 11.50 flight to Edinburgh.

"Not sure where I'll go next, but wherever, I'll definitely get a return ticket and, oh yes, next time I'll also remember to conceal the credit card bill when it pops through my door in Tayport!

While Super League outfit Bonnyrigg Rose will provide tougher opposition than Tayport have faced so far this season, the Dave Baikie's men at least go into today's Scottish Junior Cup showdown with two wins and two clean sheets under their belt.

'Port earned this afternoon's tie by seeing off North side, Cruden Bay, in a Canniepairt replay, a fortnight ago. Two early goals had the hosts in the driving seat and heading for round two of the national competition.

The opener came after fifteen minutes, when Gary Sutherland won the ball on the edge of the box and drilled his shot past visiting 'keeper Robertson. Six minutes later, Tayport doubled their advantage, with Grant Lawson dispossessing the full-back, running clear and tucking the ball home. There were further chances to add to the tally, but none were taken, so 'Port had to settle for the 2-0 win, while Cruden Bay finished the match with ten men, after Ross received a late red card.

Last week, it was back to East Premier League duty, with the short trip to Broughty Athletic's Whitton Park. The strong wind did nothing to enhance the level of entertainment on show, but Tayport did post another win, this time with a relatively late goal.

Chances were few and far between in the first half. Allan Ramsay tested Iain Ross from distance early on and Grant Lawson was off-target from a decent position, not long after Broughty's McDonald was red-carded for scything down the Tayport captain.

With the numerical advantage, the visitors bossed the game, but it was not until midway through the second half that the deadlock was broken. Recent signing Alan Tulloch was the catalyst, bursting into the area and squaring the ball to substitute Kevin Milne, who had the simple task of slotting home the winner, not long after entering the fray.

It was not a classic display, but Tayport deservedly took all three points. No doubt, however, that the Canniepairt outfit will have to play to their potential if they are to achieve success today. Let's hope that the team can rise to the challenge and provide another memorable Scottish Cup performance.

Ref in Thailand Beaten Up

February 2008. A soccer referee, Prakong Sukguamala, was beaten up by the entire Kuiburi team. The reason, referee Sukguamala was attacked was because he sent off three of their players during a vital promotion match.

Sukgumala needed 40 stitches and also broke a finger after being set upon by the Kuiburi FC squad, furious at being shown three red cards. As you have probably guessed, their team was losing at the time. The final result was 4-1 loss to Kasem Bundit.

The angry players charged into Prakong's dressing room, and started to punch and kick him. They only left when police fired gunshots into the air. The players then chased Prakong into the stadium's office, where the hapless official ran into a mirror, leaving him with cuts all over his body.

Prakong told Channel 3 television he was forced to lock himself in the room to escape his attackers. In the same interview, Kuiburi's coach accused Prakong of biased refereeing but said he had urged his players to show restraint when tempers flared.

Prakong, covered in bruises, insisted that he had refereed the game fairly, and had been asked by his soccer federation to press charges against his attackers in the Kuiburi team.

Goals from 'Port legends John Ward (R)

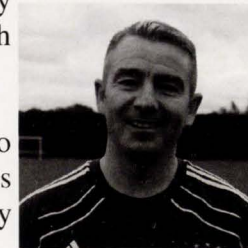
and Scott Peters (L) were enough to secure a 2-1 victory and the title.

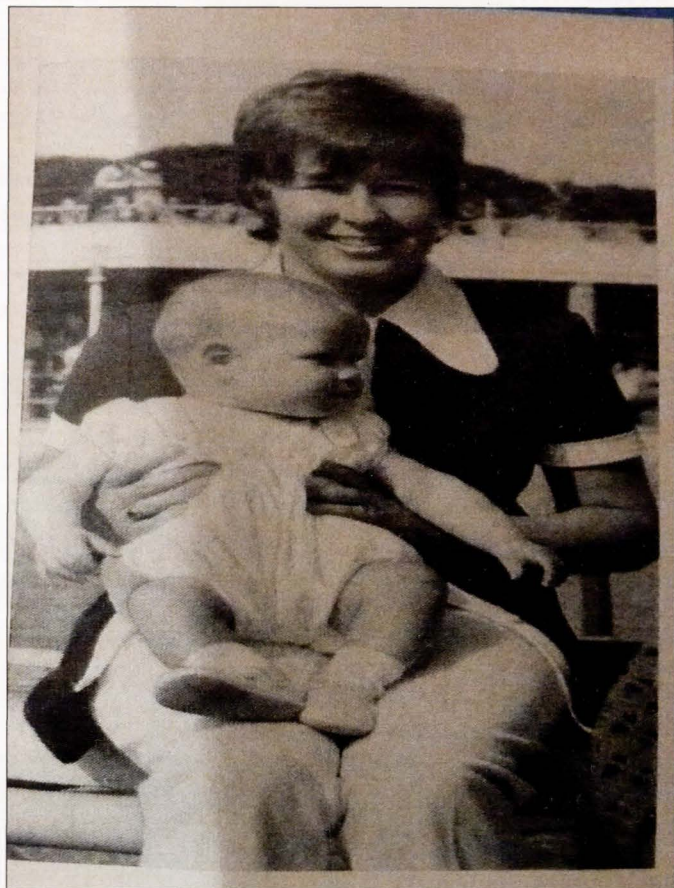
