Tayport v St Andrews Utd



For years, neighbours Tayport and St Andrews United were in different Junior associations and met only in cup ties but recent times have seen the clubs do battle in league matches. This increase in regular matches between the sides has engendered a competitive edge to what have become keenly contested games. The fact that generations of Tayport youngsters have been, and are being schooled in St Andrews, merely enhances the derby spirit which has developed between the clubs.

Throw in a number of players who have played for both clubs, add a number who stay in Tayport or St Andrews but don't play for their hometown club and you have the ingredients for what should be an exciting Premier Division game. The fact that both clubs were relegated from the Super League last season and are desperate to get back provides added spice to this afternoon's encounter.

Saints will be in buoyant mood after their 3-0 Scottish Cup win at Buckie last week whilst Tayport will be anxious to erase the memory of a home defeat by Bonnyrigg Rose in the same competition.

Joint top scorer for Saints this season is Robbie Holden who has a place in Tayport's cup history having scored the winning goal in 'Port's 2-1 extra time win over Violet in the 2003 Tayside/North Regional Cup final. Jamie Mackie had 36 games for Tayport in seasons 2011/13 while the Whyte boys, Greg and Tom, are resident in Tayport.

Tayport have three St Andreans, Ross Grant, Alan Tulleth and Gavin Wilson, in their squad whilst Neil Docherty earns a living in the Auld Grey Toon. In addition, lining up for the home side will be Tayport's close season transfer acquisition from Saints, Gary Sutherland, whose goal scoring exploits at Recreation Park over the past decade or so were legendary. Ryan Suttie also wore United's colours before moving to the Canniepairt as did Allan Ramsay, who made a close season return to the club with which he won 3 Scottish Cup winners medals.

Manager Phil McGuire will have his charges well fired up, as like his opposite number Davie Baikie, he knows the value of three points today.

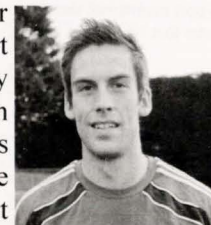

Losing week's Scottish Cup tie was a major disappointment, especially after such a promising start when I felt our formation and tactics were most certainly causing Bonnyrigg problems. 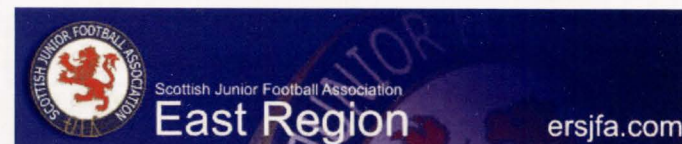

Dunmore Reports.....



Tayport's 25th Scottish Junior Cup campaign ended at the second round stage last Saturday, but only after 'Port had given Super League outfit Bonnyrigg Rose something of a fright, on the Canniepairt.

Dave Baikie's side performed really well in the opening half hour, establishing a two-goal lead and looking on course for another memorable Scottish Cup victory. Kevin Milne opened the scoring as early as the fourth minute, slotting home after some slack play by Bonnyrigg presented him with an opportunity.

Around the half hour mark, Tayport doubled their advantage. Grant Lawson raced clear and tried to chip the visiting 'keeper. While the finish wasn't quite what he would have envisaged, the attempt beat the 'Rigg custodian and ended up in the corner of the net, to the delight of the home support.

Unfortunately, the hosts were unable to reach half-time with that two-goal lead intact. The visitors started to enjoy more possession and pulled a crucial goal back, five minutes before the break, when an unmarked Ross Archibald headed past Gavin Wilson.

Two goals early in the second half turned the contest in Bonnyrigg's favour, both goals coming from corner kicks. Now trailing, Tayport found it tough to make headway against the wind, although Paul Thomson did have a header cleared off the line.

In injury-time, Bonnyrigg added a fourth, through Kevin McLeish, who netted from close-range, to finally put an end to Tayport's hopes of salvaging the tie.

While disappointing to go out of the 'Scottish' at this early stage, 'Port will now quickly turn their attention to the league campaign in general and today's derby in particular.

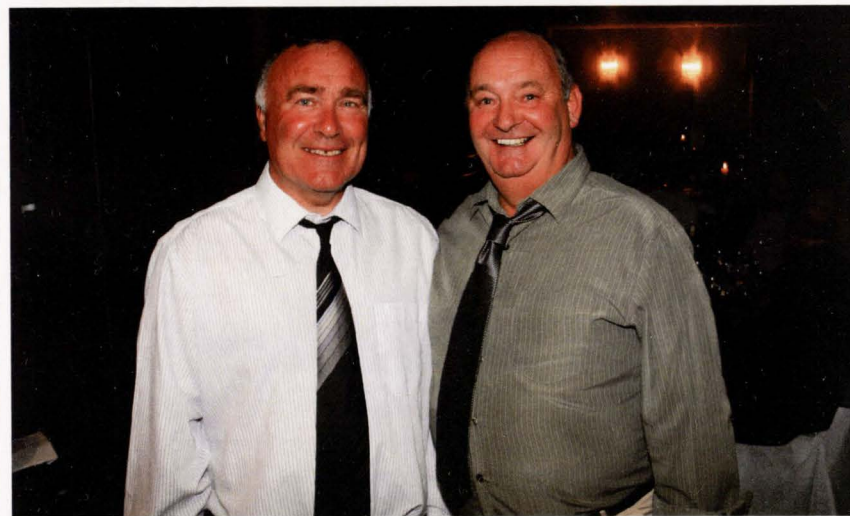

FROM THE ARCHIVES

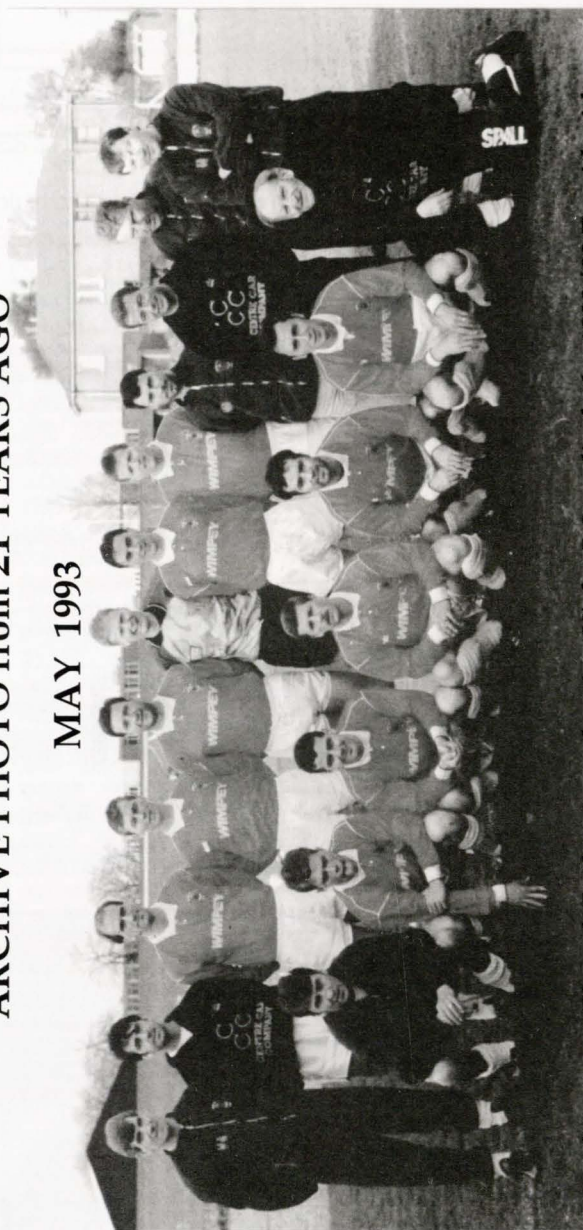
This is the comment from the **Dundee Evening Post** on **31 October 1904** following the Junior clash between St Andrews and Tayport on Sat 29 October 1904. The first game couldn't be finished as Tayport arrived in St Andrews an hour late and the games was stopped because of bad light with Tayport 3-1 ahead

Disgraceful Scenes at St Andrews.

In previous years the matches between St Andrews City and Tayport have been noteworthy on account of the keen rivalry which existed, not only amongst the players, but also amongst the spectators. The McArthur Cup tie on Saturday was no exception to the rule, and play in consequence was fast and rough. Towards the finish the referee lost all control of the players, and when the City scored the winning goal—a goal which was richly deserved on play—some-what of a rabble ensued. The referee blew his whistle and pointed to the centre of the field. The Port players crowded round him, and in angry tones disputed the point. The referee then wished to change his decision and blew his whistle for offside. This roused the City eleven, and the game was stopped for about five minutes. During this time free fights were general amongst the spectators, and it was only after Tayport had lodged a protest against the referee that the game was resumed. At the finish the crowd broke into the field, and the referee was in danger before he was escorted to safety. The City deserved their win, having the lion's share of the play. Smart was safe in goal, with Beveridge and Duncan a pair of capable defenders, the former being the more prominent. The halves played a great game, W. Brown, Jessiman, and Moncrieffe being in rattling form. Carstairs and Campbell were clever on the right, and Brown and W. Thomson equally so on the left, while A. Thomson showed some fine touches in centre. Coen gave a capital display in the Port goal. A. Oswald was as safe as a rock at back, but the halves were not nearly so prominent as the opposing trio. The forwards were kept well in check, Wilkie and Rae being the better wing, with Gray good at centre.
