Today's Game McBookie.com Premier Division Tayport v Forfar WE



Since Tayport's first season in the Juniors 25 years ago there have been many keen contests between this afternoon's two participants. Several cup finals spring to mind and what was effectively a league decider at Strathmore Park in 2010. On that occasion Tayport went to the top of the table for the very first time that season with only about 20 minutes of the campaign to go, winning 2-1 to wrest the Premier title away from a West End team who had been leading the division from virtually the start of the season. The following season West End fared far better in the Super League than Tayport, finishing respectably in mid table whilst 'Port were relegated.

It all went pear shaped for West End from there on, however, and they were forced into abeyance in season 2011/12, having to start again in the Association's third tier. But for a 6 point penalty for going into abeyance, they would have bounced back to the Premier at the first time of asking. The step up was only delayed, however, and they were promoted last season.

Under the stewardship of enthusiastic young manager Daryl McKenzie, the West End club has been revitalised both on and off the park and Forfar arrive at the Canniepairt this afternoon boasting a league run which has seen them taste defeat only once in seven games stretching back three months, a run which has lifted them into the race for promotion to the Super League.

McKenzie has been able to field a fairly settled side during this good run and the return in the win against Broughty Athletic recently, of talisman striker, the former Tayport and Arbroath FC player Darren Scott, has added significant goal threat to that already provided by top scorer Graeme Hart. Ali Smith and Mark Pirie both miss out today through suspension.

Tayport will be pleased with their return from the past two fixtures, wins at East Craigie and Kinnoull, but are likely to find West End far more tricky opponents. A number of injuries curtailed Dave Baikie's selections these past two weeks and, although there must still be some doubt, Gary Sutherland, Dale Robertson, Stefan Elvin and Matt Adam are close to regaining fitness.

Clark Kay, signed from Kelty Hearts two weeks ago, took a knock late on v Kinnoull and had to be replaced, but it's hoped he can make his home debut this afternoon.

Dunmore Reports.....



It's been a good few weeks for the club, with three wins on the bounce, as we go into this afternoon's Premier League encounter against Forfar West End.

Sandwiched in between two league victories was the GA Engineering Cup win at Craigie Park. Tayport dominated the match, but East Craigie provided a test and the visitors had to settle for a solitary goal. It was a well-worked counter, early in the first half. Alan Tulleth crossed to the far post for Grant Lawson to head back across goal, allowing the predatory Gary Sutherland to nod home what proved to be the winner.

The previous week, Alan Tulleth had been the star of the show, netting a hat-trick against St. Andrews United, one of his former clubs. His first was a low strike from inside the box, eleven minutes in. The second was something of a miscue on the half hour. Gary Sutherland, also an ex-Saint, netted Tayport's third, five minutes before the break.

Unfortunately, United were given a lifeline in injury-time at e end of the half, when Ricky Patrick was able to loop a header over Gavin Wilson. Saints continued to press after the interval, but the Canniepairt men stood firm and notched a fourth late on, when Sutherland released Tulleth who clinically netted his third goal of the afternoon.

There were two more trebles at Kinnoull last Saturday, with Grant Lawson and Kevin Milne sharing Tayport's six goals in what was a comfortable win against bottom-of-the -table 'Noull.

Lawson opened the scoring with shot which took a deflection and Milne made it two, on 23 minutes. This sparked a flurry of goals, with Lawson adding two in two minutes, immediately afterwards. His second was a fine strike, after cutting in from the left, while his third was a neat touch into the corner of the net, past the advancing 'keeper.

A lull in the scoring followed, which was perhaps understandable and Kinnoull, to their credit, did not throw in the towel. A quick fire Kevin Milne brace concluded the rout, just shy of the hour. Controlling Clark Kay's long ball, Milne eluded the 'keeper and knocked the ball into the unguarded net, then, a minute later, was on the end of Kris Rollo's low cross to net from close range, on a satisfying afternoon. The Tulloch Parkers were reduced to ten men, late on, but that mattered not, as the outcome had long since been decided.

Let's hope for more of the same today, as 'Port bid to leapfrog their promotion rivals, who will be on Scottish Cup duty this afternoon.



What's Happening At Rippin?

Here's the answer

Regulars and visitors to the Canniepairt alike, are often heard to ask what is the situation with derelict property that is the former Rippin Works adjacent to the Canniepairt. It's all on the Tayport Community Trust's (TCT) website but here we provide an abbreviated update which will in turn no doubt be further updated at the Trust's AGM on 28 November.



Tayport Community Hub

The derelict former Abertay Foundry and Rippin Steel Works in Tayport is to be transformed into a bright and vibrant new centre, featuring a mix

of COMMUNITY, SPORTS, ARTS, TOURISM and BUSINESS elements. It will create jobs, enhance health, foster sustainability, and bring renewed interest to this corner of the North of Fife. In a project led by local people through Tayport Community Trust, a new development will be constructed to create light, flexible spaces that support a range of uses as identified through engaging with the community. The building will support local community development, and be a destination for visitors. This combination will see a growth of the facility of the next 3-5 years, and continued growth within the community for many years to come.

The plans received a boost by being moved to Stage 2 of a £1m application to the Big Lottery, Growing Community Assets, Fund. This doesn't guarantee the money as yet, but shows that the Lottery see value in progressing the efforts.

The five strands of the Hub - COMMUNITY, SPORTS, ARTS, TOURISM and BUSINESS - are the pieces of the jigsaw Tayport Community Trust aims to bring over the next few years.

Fife Council will release the site to the community at nominal cost, after cleaning the site of industrial pollution. The steel frame will be given a new skin, to create light, flexible spaces that are well fitted out for a range of uses as identified through engaging with the local community.

The new building will offer something for everyone. Casual recreation for all the family; hard core facilities for the serious and strenuous; a crucible for the artistic; a home base for diverse community groups; pop up venues for community policing and health outreach; space for business development; and a café. It will create jobs, enhance health, attract visitors, foster sustainability, and bring renewed interest to this corner of the North of Fife.

This will be a destination for visitors. Sports clubs, arts fans, wildlife enthusiasts, pilgrims, walkers, cyclists, and many more including visitors to Tentsmuir Nature Reserve.

The Sports Hall will be one of the first elements of the build especially as this was one of the reasons why the Trust was established in the first place. It will include changing and storage facilities and a 5-a-side size pitch available for a range of sports and activities.

The exterior pitch will come at a later date as funding becomes available.

Comment

It's a wonderful concept and will provide a great challenge for Tayport Community Trust (TCT). Credit to the Trust for their efforts.

Meanwhile no plaudits for Fife Council who, by their failure to maintain and seal off their property, have allowed the site to drift into such a state that it's an ugly blot on the landscape and an embarrassment to the town.

Finally, however, reading through the TCT's press release, the sting is in the very last line - *The exterior pitch will come at a later date as funding becomes available.*

Unfortunately a proper 3G or 4G all weather facility - not necessarily full size - is a modern day priority for a community such as Tayport, not something to be shoved in at the end as a pipedream.

FROM THE ARCHIVES

60 YEARS AGO NOVEMBER 1954





FOOTBALL

In the 1954/55 season The Scottish Junior FA was still a very much regionalised organisation and what was most recently the Tayside Junior FA, was split into the Angus, Perthshire and Dundee Junior Leagues.

The Dundee League comprised 12 clubs, all from the city with the exception of Carnoustie Panmure. Six of the remaining eleven clubs survive but five have gone to the big league in the sky - Arnot, Stobswell, Osborne, Elmwood and St Josephs. Stobbie dropped out in 1990, the season Tayport joined the SJFA, and Elmwood and St Josephs have been casualties since. In The Courier notes of 17 Nov.1954 Junior scribe Abertay reported 'Stobbie goalkeeper Roy Jenkins leaves the city tomorrow for an interview with Middlesborough. The English club's scout at Midmill on Saturday was further impressed by Jenkins' showing against Elmwood. Fernie and Stephen, Elmwood's left wing pair, are expected to go to Leeds United this week, also for interview. Changed days indeed.

TAYPORT

The Courier's Public Notices on 17 November 1954 intimated that

"The business and premises of Kidd & Co., Aerated Water Manufacturers, Dalgleish Street, Tayport were sold with effect from 12 noon on Saturday 13th November 1954. Mr Douglas Crawford Abernethy and Mr James Ramsay Abernethy will jointly conduct the business and hereby give notice the Company will henceforth be known as The DOIG SPRING Co.

Footnote - it's possible this is the same family to which TFC season ticket holder Jimmy Abernethy is related

Among the 'FIFE ESTATES' published in The Courier that week was 'John Pearson, Glenogle, West Common, Tayport, who left £1,219'
