Today's Game East SuperLeague Tayport v Penicuik Ath



A warm welcome to the Canniepairt for Penicuik Athletic for our first meeting here in the Super League, their second visit to north Fife in three weeks. Penicuik were promoted to the Super League for the first time in 2014, replacing ourselves who dropped out, and established themselves in the top tier last season with a top six finish and that's also their current league position.

Cuikie have had something of an indifferent season to date. When we met back in October in Midlothian, the home side were enjoying a good run in the league which was to stretch to eight games unbeaten. Indeed, Cuikie's 2-0 win over Tayport put them clear at the top of the Super League. The exalted position wasn't to last, however, and a defeat at Hill of Beath ended that successful spell. A subsequent run of seven games without a win was ended in their last League outing a couple of weeks ago with a 2-1 win at St Andrews United.

Penicuik caught Tayport cold in October when Aaron Somerville netted in the opening minute and Ryan McCallum secured the points in the second half with a magnificent free kick. Somerville was the top scorer in the Lowland League last season with Whitehill Welfare while McCallum was Cuikie's top scorer that same season. No surprise, then, that these two players provide the main Penicuik goal threat, currently having scored half their side's goals between them this season.

Tayport's league form has bucked up a bit of late. Fauldhouse was a big disappointment of course, but a point at home to Sauchie and three at Newtongrange brought promise of maybe better things to come. Connaire Connelly is suspended today and John Ovenstone, at a wedding, is also unavailable but Clark Kay, unavailable last week, returns. Stefan Elvin returned to action last week and there could be a place on the bench for recent loan signing, 15 year old local lad Struan Christie.

Referee today is 30 year Lorraine Clark, a Building Surveying Technician with Fife Council. According to the SFA. Ms Clark is soon set to make history by becoming first woman to referee a Scottish Senior game. Along with her assistants, Kylie McMullan and Vikki Robertson, she took charge of the recent Montenegro v Spain Women's Euro Qualifier in Petrovac.



Manager's Memo



Hi, welcome to this afternoon's game

Dunmore Reports



Tayport have had a mixed bag of results in their last three Super League encounters, with a draw, a defeat and a win, against Sauchie, Fauldhouse and Newtongrange, respectively.

Four points from nine is not a bad return, given the lack of points since August, but there is disappointment that the three games did not yield more points. When Sauchie came to town three weeks ago, 'Port put themselves in the driving seat by taking a two goal lead. Twenty minutes into the contest, Gary Sutherland found Dale Reid and his low cross was turned into his own net by Sauchie's Steve Dolan, with Danny Cavanagh waiting to pounce.

The ball did come Cavanagh's way ten minutes later and he curled a beauty into the top corner, with Reid again the provider of the pass.

The visitors pulled one back before half-time. Gavin Sorley saved Brian Morgan's spot kick but Iain Diack reacted quickest to net the rebound. Five minutes into the second half, John Tully levelled matters and Tayport had to dig deep to secure the draw.

Next up was a trip to Fauldhouse, for a so-called six-pointer. It was an opportunity for the Canniepairt men to close the gap on second bottom 'Hoose, but it was the hosts who came out on top. Home skipper Michael Browne squeezed in a 40th minute penalty to open the scoring and, late in the day, Jordan Love netted to seal the points.

So, after that disappointment, a match away to Newtongrange Star looked like being a tough prospect, but 'Port came through that test with flying colours. If anything, the margin of victory could have been far higher than the 1-0 win. Marc Ogg was the matchwinner, blasting home a 71st minute penalty.

Star had a couple of close things in the first half, including a free kick which smacked off the bar. The second half belonged to Tayport though. Dale Reid (*right*), Alan Tulleth and Danny Cavanagh all had excellent chances before Ogg's spot kick. After the goal, Tulleth and Reid both went close, but Connaire Connelly was red-carded for a late tackle, in the closing stages.



There was still time for Dale Reid to earn another penalty, which Ogg took, only for 'keeper McQueen to make the save. The full-time whistle, however, was not far away and the Tayport contingent could celebrate a long-awaited victory. Let's hope the next one comes along soon.

1995/96 CUP RUN - Part 9

Continuing the historic road to Fir Park and Scottish Cup glory

If there was ever any doubt that Tayport FC were emerging as a genuine force in the Junior game, these doubts were dispelled after Auchinleck Talbot were disposed of at the semi-final stage for the second time in four years.

Manager Baikie didn't see the need to shuffle his line-up and fielded the same eleven who had beaten Lochee United 4-1 six days previously in a local cup-tie. The only change from the quarter final win over Rob Roy was Keith Nicolson in for Grant Buist in central defence


Fraser Mann; Grant Miller, Grant Paterson, Mark Spalding, Keith Nicolson, Sean Wilkie, Allan Ramsay, Steven Stewart, Hamish Mackay, Dave Reilly and Stephen Ross were charged with getting Tayport into the final. On the subs' bench were Jim Henry, Barry Gray, Gary Maher, Grant Buist and Billy Coventry.

An attendance of 3,016 [1,800 from Tayport according to **The Sun**] rolled up at Fir Park, Motherwell on Friday April 12th to see Tayport win 2-0. The opening goal came just before half time. The **Daily Record** reported "Grant Miller created the goal with a mazy run past three defenders before flicking in a shot which [Talbot keeper] Wilson was unable to hold. Mighty atom Stevie Ross was lurking just six yards out and turned the ball into the empty net. Ross celebrated as if he had won the cup itself, while Miller's magical contribution seemed to be ignored"

Tayport increased their lead on 65mins through Steven Stewart after which there was no road back for the Ayrshire Champions. **The Sun** described Steven's goal from 30 yards as a "stunning glory strike" after which "Stewart raced off to celebrate in front of the huge Tayport support in the main stand with his teammates struggling to catch hold of him"

It was a happy Port Support which returned to Tayport from Fir Park, looking forward to the four week build-up to the cup final on Sunday 12th May. It would be against cup holders Camelon who knocked out Pollok on penalty kicks after a 0-0 draw at Love Street, Paisley in the other semi-final three days later

Now, there are some who might well cast doubt on the authenticity of this story but it's recorded in the Archives so must be true! "There was a pleasant surprise for some supporters when they got back to the Bellrock Tavern after the semi final win. Andy Robertson [aka Bunt] had phoned the Bell from Dubai to put up a few rounds of celebratory drinks for the regulars"



30 YEARS AGO- 100 YEARS AGO

.....March 1986

What a month **March 1986** was for Tayport FC. After reaching the 6th Round of the Scottish Amateur Cup back in January (as noted in our last programme), because of postponements, Tayport had to wait seven weeks to play their 6th round tie. The team had managed to play five 'domestic' fixtures in the interim however and this was to stand them in good stead.

On successive Saturdays, **22nd March, 29th March and 5th April**, Tayport played three ties and suddenly found themselves in the last four of the Scottish and a semi final date at Dens Park awaiting them

On 22 March, Edinburgh's **Liberton Cropley** were eliminated by 2-1 on Canniepairt with goals from Graeme Cox and Bruce Burnett. A week later it was an all-Tayside 7th round tie against Cup favourites **Riverside Athletic** at Charlotte Street. Tayport rose magnificently to the occasion, upsetting the odds by again winning by 2-1, Alan Gray and Mike Smith netting the goals.

The momentum was with Tayport and although a quarter final tie away to **Leith Wanderers** looked an awesome task, 'Port scraped through by 3-2 on a windy Leith Links thanks to goals from Ronnie Stewart, Jim Bissett and Bruce Burnett.
