Tayport v Camelon Jrs



A warm welcome to the players, committee and supporters of Camelon to the Canniepairt for this afternoon's Super League game.

On Wednesday evening Camelon get their first win of the season, 2-0 at Sauchie, whilst at the same time Tayport became entrenched at the foot of the division following a 1-0 defeat by Carnoustie, a result which sent the Gowfers to the top of the league.

Camelon will always have a place in Tayport's history of course, as it was 20 years ago this season that Tayport defeated the Mariners at Fir Park to win the first of their three Scottish Junior Cups in ten years.

The Super League is a different story, however with Tayport managing only one Super League win v Camelon in six attempts on our home patch. Indeed we've scored only four goals during that period.

Camelon have retained the basis of last season's side which although finishing well short of any championship challenge, ended up a comfortable ten points clear of the relegation play-off spot.

Among those added to the squad are new goalkeeper David Kane, a Scottish Amateur Select choice from Stein's Thistle, the former Stenhousemuir and Glasgow Rangers midfielder Gregor Fotheringham and Jamie Glasgow, another midfield man who was formerly with East Stirlingshire.

Tayport had Scott Finlay (suspension), Neil Docherty (holiday) and Johnny McRae (working away), missing in midweek and only Johnny will be available today. Set to make a home debut is Drew Fleming, a defender, signed from Kinnoull in midweek.

Striker Matty Adam, who had a miserable time through injury last term, has been in the USA for the past four months and word is he's back at the beginning of September.

THE "BAIKER'S" BIT



It goes without saying that the past couple of weeks hasn't been the best of times for us. After a decent performance at Linlithgow we've lost our way in games, in both the St Andrews and Newtongrange games we've had good possession but let ourselves down at both ends of the pitch.

In two of our 3 reversals we've missed gilt edged opportunities to take the lead and if we take then then whole picture changes, we take a huge lift, our opponents start to get anxious, start to chase the game, commit more players forward and in turn leave gaps for us to exploit but it's not happened. At the other end we've made too many unforced errors and where we'd possibly got away with some of these mistakes last term we've rightly been punished in this division.

On Wednesday at Carnoustie I felt it was an opportunity to get a first win under our belt and at half time with the scoreline at 0-0 and a 1st half with little scoring opportunities for both sides we were definitely in with a chance. We are one win away from moving up the division and that will give us confidence moving forward. Of course it goes without saying we have to improve from top to bottom, every player has to look within and raise their individual performance, minimise the errors, create and take our chances. We must improve to succeed, there's no point in saying we were unlucky, we have to "Make it Happen".

I'm working hard to strengthen the squad and will leave no stone unturned to improve the playing staff, it hasn't been easy to do that to date but I can assure our fans I will be relentless in that task.

Camelon JFC are our visitors for this afternoon's league game I'd like to take this opportunity to welcome them to Tayport. Like Wednesday, I see today's game as an opportunity to get our first victory in this division but as I said, to achieve that we must improve as individuals and as a team. I believe there is also room to increase our work rate and if we can put it all together then there is no doubt we can be successful this afternoon.

After an encouraging start to life in the Super League, when only a late Linlithgow equaliser denied Tayport all three points at Prestonfield, the last three results have been disappointing. St. Andrews won the local derby ten days ago, then Newtongrange Star notched a 3-0 win on the Canniepairt last weekend.

In that match, there didn't seem to be much to choose between the sides, in terms of the general play, but a couple of basic errors gave Star a cushion. Kevin Milne had had an early goal chalked off for a foul and Star took the lead on the half hour. A cross from the left was not dealt with and the opposing centre halves combined, with David Dunn heading home.

In the second half, Matty King cashed in on a mistake at the back and lobbed the helpless Gavin Wilson, to give Newtongrange a comfortable lead. With 'Port looking to get back into the game, they were caught out late on and substitute Chris King rounded Wilson to slot in goal number three.

So to Laing Park on Wednesday evening. It was hoped that Tayport could post a morale-boosting win, but it was not to be their night in front of goal. Kevin Milne (R) was just off-target early in proceedings and later saw a couple of efforts pushed away to safety by 'keeper MacPherson. Alan Tulleth and Stefan Elvin both had shots blocked during the game and Connaire Connelly was unable to convert Dean Rennie's low cross, in what was the best opening of the match.



The Gowfers, to be fair, were not without their chances and took one of them on 80 minutes. Striker McCabe strode forward and fired a left-footer into the corner of the net from the edge of the box, to deflate the visitors.

Let's hope for a positive display and better fortune against Camelon this afternoon.

From the Archives August 1945

Football in Tayport 70 years ago

Back in the late summer and early autumn of 1945, World War 2 had just ended and organised football was just starting to get back into the swing. Tayport had two teams, both playing in the resuscitated Angus Amateur Association. The Angus Association consisted of one league of 12 teams and the Angus Amateurs' Boys' League which on 31 August 1945 listed only 4 games, Abertay v Tayport XI, Broughty v CBS XI, Dunkeld v Butterburn and Taybank v Ashdale.

Tayport Violet were in the top tier whilst the other team, described in the press as 'a new boys team at Tayport' were variously described in the match listings during August as Tayport Senior Scouts, Tayport XI and Tayport Violet XI. It was the same team, however, and indeed was the origins of the club we have today, having broken away from Tayport Violet in 1947 to join the Midlands Amateur FA.

The Tayport Senior Scouts team which was listed in the Evening Telegraph to play at Abertay in a league fixture 70 years ago this week was:-

J.Rae; Coss and Anderson; Cavanagh, L.C. Dempster and Dempster; Hughes, Donaldson, Treiwearn, Howe and Kidd. Reserves were Carmichael, Hill, McDonald, and Soutar. Train leaves Tayport at 1.40pm, the note added.

Tayport's No. 10 that day 70 years ago was Jock Howe who regularly drives from his home in Monifieth to take his place in the enclosure at the Canniepairt and has been at both home games so far this season.
