

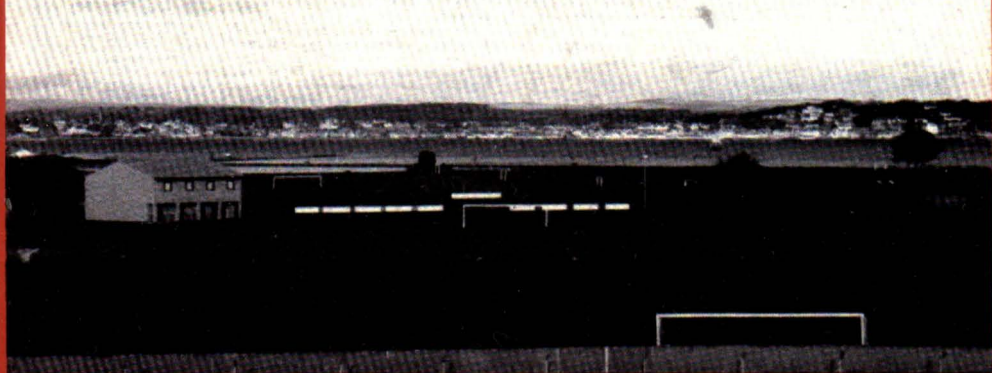

Today's Game McBookie.com Super League Tayport v Muirkirk Jrs



A warm welcome to north Fife to the players, management and supporters of our visitors today, Muirkirk Juniors, from East Ayrshire,. Muirkirk, now a community with a population of around 2,000, once had a thriving mining industry, but like many places with Junior football clubs located in the former industrial areas, it has suffered from the closure of these industries.

It's 25 years since their only previous visit to Tayport. No doubt there will be one or two in the Muirkirk party today who will recall that visit to the Canniepairt in 1990 but maybe not recognise the place.

Although it's always good to have an away day, the Muirkirk treasurer must have groaned when his team were drawn away from home, having been at Lochee United last season and Dunbar the season before. There hasn't been much success for Muirkirk on the road in the national competition in recent times, the last success being in 2008 on a marathon trip up north to eliminate Strathspey Thistle by 2-0.

The new management team of George Grierson, Gary Russell and Kevin Deeney took over the reins in the summer, with the intention of improving the fortunes of a club which had struggled in the bottom tier of the West Region for too long.

There are indications that things are improving and a narrow defeat by 1-0 at Johnstone Burgh in the West of Scotland Cup and progress to the 3rd round of the Scottish Cup, following a 3-2 win over fellow Ayrshire District League side Craigmark Burntonians, are testimony to that upsurge in fortune.

Muirkirk, anxious to make the 4th round for the first time in many years and possibly secure a decent payday, have been trying to boost their pool this week and a couple of new signings could make their debut today.

Tayport were disappointed when the woodwork possibly denied them a point v Broughty last week, after having reduced a three goal deficit to a single goal.

Marc Ogg, suspended last week, and Connor Macleod and Alan Tulleth, who were in Paris and Barcelona respectively last week, are available for selection.

Dunmore Reports.....



Tayport returned to Super League action last weekend, after a month of cup ties on the road. Broughty Athletic were the visitors to the Canniepairt and included four former 'Port players in their squad. Ian Ross and Grant Lawson started the game, Jake Mair came off the bench and Bryan Duell was an unused substitute. So, that, coupled with the fact that Broughty are, geographically, Tayport's nearest neighbours, a cracking contest was on the cards.

The Fed' opened the scoring on 11 minutes, when Kevin Buchan latched onto a through ball and sent his low strike from the edge of the box past Gavin Wilson, into the corner of the net. Then, in injury-time at the end of the half, Broughty scored again. Jamie Winter delivered a free kick low into the area and the ball broke kindly for Buchan, who poked home his second counter of the game. On the hour, the Whitton Parkers added a third. Jamie Winter played in Paul McLellan, who raced clear, rounded Wilson and slotted home.

So, the opening hour certainly didn't go Tayport's way. For the remainder of the match, however, John Ovenstone's men pushed Broughty hard. Kris Rollo (*Photo R*) was the main man, scoring twice to put his side within touching distance of their opponents. On 64 minutes, Rollo was well-placed to flick the ball past Iain Ross, then, three minutes later, he headed home from a corner kick, to make it 2-3.



Tayport came close to an equaliser shortly afterwards. Gary Sutherland teed up midfielder Scott Finlay and he unleashed a powerful strike which thumped against the crossbar. Broughty therefore survived and added a fourth goal in stoppage time. Former captain Grant Lawson picked up possession wide on the right and danced his way into the box before netting a cruel blow to the Canniepairt outfit.

Let's hope a return to cup action brings a return to winning ways this afternoon, against Muirkirk. There were certainly encouraging signs in the final half hour of the last weekend's match, so 'Port should go into the tie with some confidence.

1995/96 CUP RUN - Part 4

Tayport were held at home by Baillieston and the trip to Glasgow's East End for the replay on December 9th looked a daunting task. It was an early start for Tayport who took a decent following through to the west. Manager Baikie was to spring a surprise by including in the starting line-up midfielder Jim Henry who had been signed from Lochee United on the eve of the replay and registered at the SFA offices only a few hours before kick off by Tayport committee members en route to the tie.

It was a bit of a gamble by the Tayport boss to put Henry straight into the team in place of 'flu victim Gary Maher as he hadn't played for 5 weeks. The gamble paid off, however, with Tayport recording a comfortable 3-0 win before an attendance of 336. The bookies hadn't given Tayport much of a chance so the punters amongst the Port support cleaned up at the Baillieston branch of Wm Hill's. Before the tie the bookies had Tayport priced at 16/1 to lift the cup with the usual suspects Pollok and Auchinleck the low priced favourites.

The *Evening Telegraph* on the eve of the replay expected "the Fifers to be in for a torrid time against a team with a reputation of being a very physical side"

The *Sunday Post* reported "a first class second half display from Tayport put them into the fourth round of the OVD Scottish Cup with a convincing 3-0 win over Central League Baillieston"

The *Courier* thought "stylish midfielder Jim Henry, despite not playing a competitive game for five weeks, did well..."

The *Fife Herald* reported "A scintillating second half display by Tayport fired them into the last 32 of the OVD Scottish CupTayport sprang a surprise by fielding 11th hour signing Jim Henry and the youngster delighted the travelling support with an impressive debut"

It's fair to say that those who were at the East of Scotland Cup tie at Kelty were well impressed with the totally refurbished Central Park.. Although the refurbishment is still a work in progress, it's fair to say that, on completion, it will be a facility of which Kelty Hearts and the local community in general can be justly proud. The new artificial surface is excellent, the fencing, paved areas and leaning barriers are in place plus there's a neat wee social club and plenty parking space. The floodlighting pylons are there and covered spectator accommodation is in the pipeline. Mind you, as part of a project costing Fife Council £7,000,000, one would expect it to be state of the art.

Those of us who watched the BBC programmes 'The Class of '92', on the acquisition of Salford City FC by the former Manchester United stars, might have recognised some of the locations at which Salford City played. Hurst Cross, home of Ashton United was where Tayport won the Tameside International Cup in 1996 and Lancaster City was where we enjoyed a 6-1 win over the locals in a pre-season friendly in 1993.

Tayport FC Honorary President Andy Phin, not exactly a giant of a man, in terms of height anyway, mentioned from time to time that he was once a goalie. Well, he wasn't kidding. Carrying out some research, our man uncovered the evidence in a *Dundee Courier & Advertiser* from almost 70 years ago, dated 15 March 1946. It listed the Tayside Rangers team to play 5th BB FC. Tayside Rangers played their home games at either Tayport or Newport depending on where they could find a pitch [Tayport had two other football teams at that time.] The newspaper only listed surnames but Andy recalled most of the forenames of the team which was:- Andy Phin; Dite Carmichael, Johnston, Duncan, Tam Mills; Norman Pattie, Bert Aitken, Alex Finlay, Johnny Anderson, Bill Scott and Maurice Milne. Reserves were Kenny Keir and Robert Westwater.

There are clear links with today's Tayport FC and the Tayside Rangers team of seventy years ago. As well as the Andy Phin (left) connection,

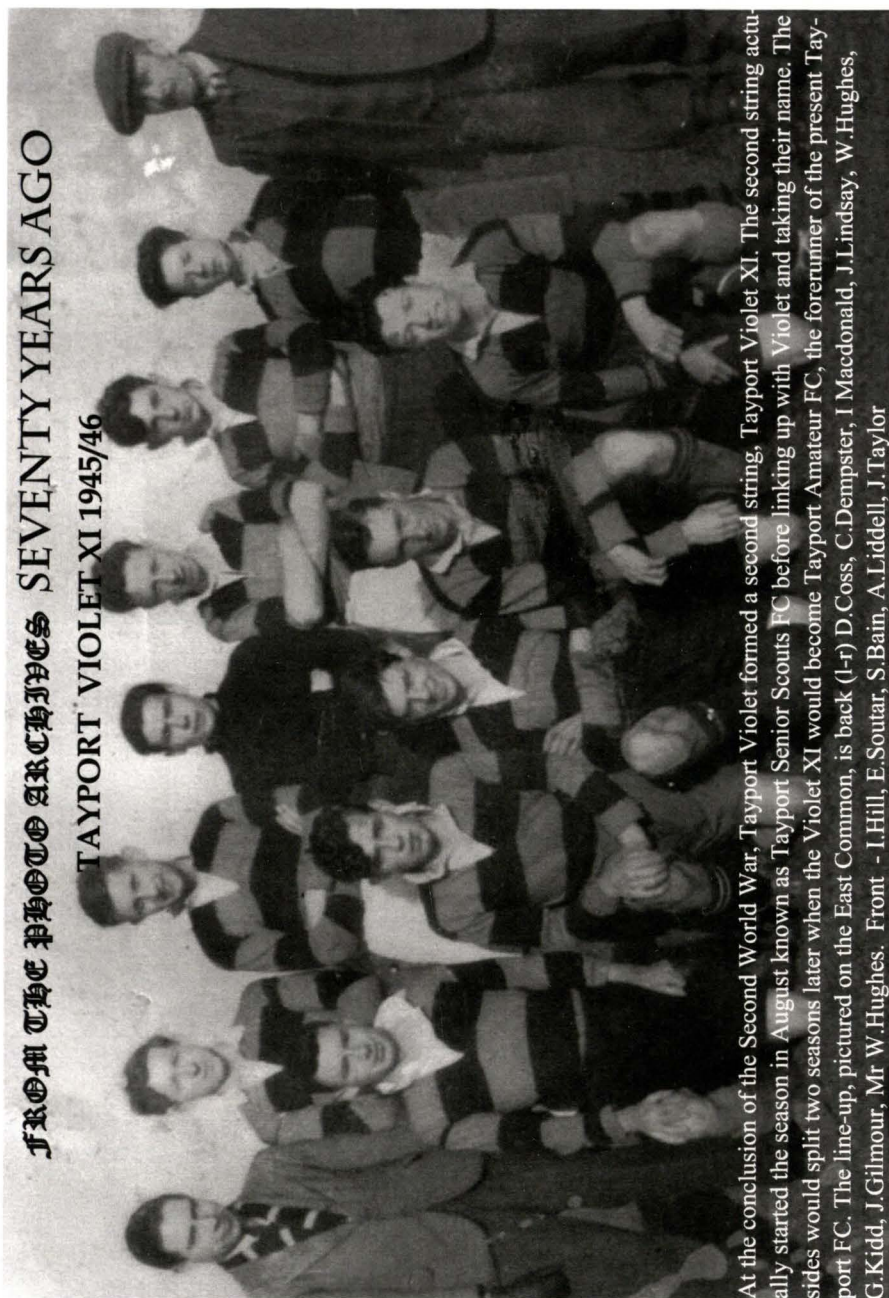
