Forfar Albion are sitting mid table with 5 points from 4 games beating Arbroath Vics 2-1, losing 5-1 at North End drawing 2 games at Newburgh 3-3 and Lochore Welfare on Saturday 2-2.

Albion Manager, Dave Thomson (*pic R*), shouldn't have any problems fielding a team unlike the Tayport Manager a few weeks ago who had a limited choice due to holidays and injuries. Tayport go into today's cup tie on the back of three successive East Premier League wins. The run started with a mid-weeker against Violet, then Whitburn came to town, a fortnight ago.

The Canniepairt outfit created a host of chances throughout the encounter and thoroughly deserved their 3-1 win. Around the half hour, Dale Reid (*pic R*) raced away down the left channel and beat the 'keeper with a clinical near post finish. It was not until the 60-minute mark that the lead was doubled, courtesy of Liam Ross, who netted his first goal for the club, following a corner kick. Whitburn were then awarded a penalty kick, which was converted by Martin Russell, reducing the deficit. Fortunately, Tayport responded quickly and Dale Reid netted his second of the game, to seal the points, when he evaded the goalkeeper and slotted home. Reid came close to a hat-trick, but his shot crashed against the bar, in the closing stages.

It was a good win and very positive performance and the hope was that 'Port could produce again at Haddington.



They did so, matching the 3-1 scoreline. The opening goal came courtesy of Jamie Mackie's (*pic L*) first half penalty, after Dale Reid had been fouled inside the area. Around the hour mark, Connaire Connelly (*pic R*) added Tayport's second, sending a wonderful strike into the top corner from thirty-five yards out, for an early 'Goal of the Season' contender.



Less than two minutes later, the Hi-Hi's halved the deficit, with Chris Cairney netting a terrific goal of his own. Not to be outdone, Alan Tulloch (*pic R*) got in on the act, curling a beauty into the top corner for another fantastic goal. This counter, coupled with a solid save by Gavin Sorley, would ensure that Tayport would collect three valuable points.



A different challenge awaits this afternoon, with cup progress on the agenda. Let's hope for another positive display. Support the 'Port!

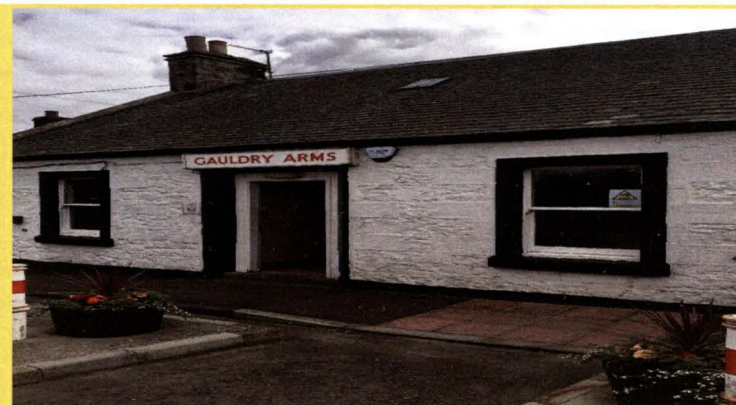

Former East Fife Team Mates Meet up at Haddington after 52 yrs



Last Saturday's game at Haddington Athletic saw Dick Smith (L) and Jake Young meet up after 52 years having been teammates at East Fife in 1964.

Jakes playing career included spells at Dundee FC, Arbroath, East Fife, St Mirren and eventually Player/Manager at Forfar athletic. Jake has stayed in Haddington for 9 years.

After East Fife Dick moved to Australia to play. One of Dick's highlights of his 13 years playing career in the Australian Leagues, was winning an Australian Cup Medal. His low was a double leg break while playing in the Australian 1st Division aged 30 years. After a long rehabilitation he played on as 'sweeper' in the 4th Division until he was 38 years old.

FROM THE ARCHIVES

47 Years Ago...June 1969

The Club had only five committee members, the money in the bank was £15 and cash in hand was £5:1s:9d. The club had held a dinner dance in the Seymour Hotel. An account for 48 Dinners @17/6d had been received but only 44 had attended. It was decided to send Mr Dickson [Seymour] £38:10/-, not £42 as stated in the account.

A letter was sent to RAF Leuchars to request training facilities. A rota was to be drawn up for running the club's Bingo sessions.

Pegs left lying after taking down the goal nets had damaged the mower. Team captain would now be responsible for collecting pegs. F Bremner had offered to get paint for the club hut at a much reduced price but Eddie Stewart advised he could get it cheaper!

43 Years Ago....November 1973

A Lawside FP player had been charged with assaulting Tayport player Ian White during a Midlands match on the East Common.

The club was in dispute with Tayport Town Council over the club's claim for expenses for the recent rip to Belgium. Only £155.22p had been paid instead of and expected £204.44p. Items not paid for were football hose and shorts, tracksuits, scarves and berets. The club's argument was that these items had been acquired so as not to make the club appear scruffy whilst representing the Burgh abroad.

35 Years Ago....September 1981

Club funds were £300 but there were outstanding accounts with David Low (£79), A Roberts (£100) and for lamps (£120) but regardless, portable goals were to be purchased at cost of £279.

Eric Sinclair [Dundee FC] was coaching the team and was reported to be doing a fine job although there were too many players and an assistant was being sought to help Sinky by looking after the training needs of the Fife and Alliance teams.

Drew Herd's firm, KKE Contracts, donated a new set of goal nets.

An under 18s Disco in the Gregory Hall realised £116 for club funds.

Madras FP Rugby Club and the Royal British Legion had both asked if Tayport FC would run a Racenight for their funds.
