Today's Game Mc.bookie East Premier league Tayport v Dalkeith Thistle



A warm welcome today to Dalkeith Thistle Committee, Management, Players and Supporters to the Canniepairt. Dalkeith Thistle were formed in 1892 and play at Kings Park in Dalkeith. Not surprisingly their nickname is "The Jags".



"The Jags" arrive at the Canniepairt on the back of an East of Scotland Cup defeat by Boness United 3-5 on pens after leading 2-1 with ten minutes to go last Saturday. Thistle will be encouraged by their performance against the Super League side with manager Kevin Haynes (*pic L*) hoping to improve the clubs league position against Tayport today.

Dalkeith's six league games this season have produced three defeats at home but they are unbeaten away from home winning one game and drawing the other two. Recent signing Daryl Devlin looks a good acquisition having scored twice on his debut against Boness.

Tayport have only ever met Dalkeith four times. All in Premier league games. In Season 2012/13 on the 29 Sept 2012 Tayport won 8 - 1 in front of a crowd of 124. The return fixture on 30 March 2013 Tayport took the points again in a 0-5 win watched by 103 fans.

Then in season 2014/15, 30 August 2014 a 2-2 draw was well contested in front of a crowd of 96. The return fixture on 28 March 2015 saw Tayport winning 0-2. Attendance 101.

Of the current Tayport players only Alan Tulleth has played v Dalkeith for Tayport in the March 28 2015 game. Simon Murray scored 3 in the 8-1 game and 2 in the 5-0. Last week Dundee United turned down a bid from Hibs for Simon's transfer.

Both season's in which 'Port have played Dalkeith, Tayport went on to win the Premier Division Championship.

Port Manager John Ovenstone will be hoping to make it five victories in a row today.

It was good to see Daniel Sanchez and Kieron Conway get on the score sheet for the first time in the 4-1 win against Forfar Albion last week.

There's big competition for places in the team and that is definitely helping our cause as players are on there toes every week to keep there jersey in the starting line up.

Hopefully today we continue this run to five wins on the bounce going into the break next week due to Falkirk folding.

Reports



Tayport will be back on league duty today, against Dalkeith, but cup business was on the agenda last weekend. Forfar Albion were the visitors to the Canniepairt, in the first round of the DJ Laing East of Scotland Cup.

Having suffered some woes in recent seasons, Albion have made a more positive start to this campaign and acquitted themselves well last week. Indeed, they shocked their hosts by taking a 15th minute lead, through Ryan Anderson.

Thankfully, the equaliser was not long in coming, with midfielder Daniel Sanchez (pic R) opening his account for the season, stroking home a fine finish from just inside the box. Both sides had opportunities before the break, but the next goal did not come until the hour mark.



Last season's top scorer, Alan Tulleth, latched onto a

Stuart Walton pass, scampered away into the box and bent the ball into the far

corner of the net, to put his side 2-1 up.



Kieron Conway (pic L) gave 'Port a two-goal cushion ten minutes later, when he stooped at the far post to head home a corner. The scoring was completed late on, when substitute Dale Reid showed great determination to get his name on the scoresheet, for the fourth time in five games.

It was good to make cup progress and record a fourth successive win, which certainly breeds confidence, but Tayport face a stiffer challenge today and will have to be at their best if they are to glean another three East Premier League points.


