It's a warm welcome to Brechin Vics and belated congratulations on reaching defender, it will be their Centenary. 100 years old last year!

Brechin Vics and Tayport have always played in the same Junior Association. vet this will be the first meeting of the teams on Canniepairt for 27 years.

Indeed they have only met each other on six previous occasions, the most recent being as long ago as 14 years, in this very competition at Victoria Park.

Vics have long lived in the shadow of Senior neighbours Brechin City and this perhaps partly explains the relative lack of success and silverware in Victoria Park trophy cabinet. It is 38 years since a last cup success and even longer, 67 years, since a last league title.

There are signs of things changing, however, under the guidance of the new manager this season, Phil McGuire.

McGuire, the former

Aberdeen FC and **Dunfermline Athletic** recalled, had a successful spell as manager at St Andrews United prior to an Harp by 6-1 in Dundee. acrimonious departure from Recreation Park.

The former Saints boss has a blueprint in place to raise Vics profile and to create a side to achieve on-pitch



success.

McGuire is ambitious and sees bringing through young players as the key to building towards future success. To this end Vics' boss plans to bring in around six new players in the close season.

Recruitment has already started with Gordon Ramsay having recently been signed from Lochee Harp.

Perhaps a measure of the improvement in recent times has been the two North Division results v Lochee Harp this season. Back at the beginning of October Vics lost 7-3 at home to Harp while in their only fixture since the turn of the year, Vics cuffed

Tayport have had something of a love affair with this Cup competition, having won it on eight occasions despite not entering it from 2005 to 2014. With Charlie King having previously managed Vics after a lengthy career with Senior neighbours Brechin City, he will not only be trying to continue this love affair but will be anxious to put one over his former club. Of course, the Vics players will be equally keen to put one over Charlie!

Ricky Patrick's loan spell has ended and work commitments continue to rule out Gregor Anderson but local youngsters Fraser Anderson, Struan Christie, and Luke O'Brien and have returned to the fold and are available for selection following the expiry of their loan spells at Newburgh Juniors.

As Used By Tayport FC

JOHN McGLASHAN



Club members were shocked recently to learn of the sudden death of former team manager John McGlashan who succumbed to motor neurone disease aged only 50.

John was manager at Tayport FC from April 2011 until October 2013, leading the club to promotion to the Super League in 2012/13, finishing the season with a run of seven successive league victories to

clinch the step-up at Penicuik on the last day of the campaign.

John's enthusiasm for the game knew no bounds, whether it was collecting pots of soup from the Harbour Café for the players to enjoy after training or rolling the muddy training pitch single handed prior to an evening training session.

John can be credited with resurrecting the career of Simon Murray after signing the present Hibernian striker for Tayport from Montrose FC.

John had started his football career at Montrose FC before a £50,000 transfer to Millwall and played on loan with Fulham and Cambridge United prior to a £95,000 transfer to Peterborough United. He moved on to Rotherham United for three years before a move back home to sign for Dundee where the club's promotion to the Premiership quickly followed. Moves to Arbroath, Ross County and Arbroath again followed, before taking up the managerial reins at Gayfield where he was in charge for 4 years until 2009.

We pass on our sincere condolences to John's wife Dawn, son John jnr., stepdaughter Hollie and other family members.

Dundee Crematorium was packed out for John's funeral on Monday January 29th where warm tributes were paid to one of football's gentleman. Club representatives were in attendance along with a good number of players who wore the Tayport colours whilst the club was under John's management.

TROM THE ARCHIVES

A local derby report from 1904

Last weekend **114 years** ago Tayport and St Andrews City drew 2-2 a replayed Armitage Cup Final at Rattray Park in Leuchars, a game which was described as 'another battle' (the teams had drawn 4-4 in the first game).

The final didn't get off to the best of starts when before the game St Andrews protested that the referee had been changed without their knowledge but that seemed to have cut no ice and 'a large crowd lined the ropes' as play got underway.

St Andrews were 1-0 ahead at half-time through Manson but Oswald levelled with a penalty early in the second half.

'At this juncture an extraordinary scene occurred, Messer of Tayport striking one of the spectators whereupon the crowd broke in and it looked as if it would have to be abandoned, but, eventually order was restored. The remainder of the game was rough. Tayport added a second point [goal] through Rae and the City equalised from a foul [free kick], Louden scoring with a splendid shot"

The 'Notes' to the match report read as follows:

'Both teams had one alteration from the lot which had represented them a fortnight previous. The City had Chapman of the University vice [as substitute for] Campbell indisposed; Tayport had Campbell vice J. Cowie. The game all through was a rough and tumble one, and Messer of Tayport did not improve it when he rushed off the field and struck one of the spectators. When will footballers recognise that they are out to play a fair game of football-not to give a prize fighting exhibition? As regards the penalty awarded to Tayport, the referee seemed to have taken into his head to present a goal to Tayport. In fact he blew his whistle before an offence was committed. On the day's play a draw was a pretty fair criterion.'
