We welcome Hall Russell United to the Canniepairt for the first time.

Hall Russell United play their football in the North Region's top level, the Super League, and have made steady progress in terms of league position over the past three seasons and that progress looks to be maintained this time round.

There have been mixed fortunes since the turn of the year but the 2-1 win at home v Stonehaven last week delivered a crucial three points in respect of league placings.

Key midfielder Andrew Davidson and former Aberdeen FC youngster Hamish MacLeod were both on the mark, the latter making his first home start since signing for the club last month.

The main goal threat from Hall Russell today is likely to come from MacLeod and top scorer Elliott MacDonald (pictured).

Manager John Carroll has seen his side eliminate First



Division teams Lewis United and Stoneywood/ Parkvale from this season's competition, Lewis on penalty kicks after a 1-1 draw.

Carroll is the longest serving manager in the North Region, having held the reins since before many of his players were born and he would dearly love to see his club finally make their mark in this competition.

Tayport disappointed their support last week by not taking three points from Arniston but the draw did stretch their recent unbeaten run.

Charlie King knows his players have to be sharper in front goal and this is likely to influence his starting eleven today.

Matthew Strachan, who moved back to Scone Thistle after making only one start, could be followed back over the Tay by Kamil Kadela who is interesting Dundee Violet..

Marc Ogg has been taken off the transfer list. At his own request.

ship building firm of the same name founded in 1864 and which continued in business until 1992. The yard had a football history. From 1915 until 1958, a Junior club, Hall Russell's, played out of the Shipyard and are one of only three North Region clubs to have ever reached the Scottish Junior Cup Final. In Hall Russell's case they lost out to Newtongrange Star in the 1930 final.

The Tayside/North Regional Cup Competition

The competition for clubs based in the North Region and the former Tayside Region kicked off in 1988. Zamoyski Vodka was the competition's first sponsor and there have been several sponsors since but from 2006 the competition has been sponsored by GA engineering.

To say that North clubs haven't exactly made their mark on the competition would be something of an understatement. Deveronside won the first of the 29 finals in 1989 but since then, only Sunnybank, twice, from the North Region have got their name on the Cup.

Tayport, despite not entering between 2006 and 2014, have won it on eight occasions. St Josephs (4), Lochee United (3), Forfar West End (2), Jeanfield Swifts (2), , Downfield (2), North End (2), Kirrie Thistle, Montrose Roselea and Broughty Athletic are the others who have lifted the trophy. Montrose, of course, now play their football in the North Region.
