First and Last

A warm welcome to Tayport for our visitors this afternoon from West Lothian, for what will be recalled in years to come as a major milestone in Blackburn United's history - their last ever game in the Juniors.

Apart from a couple of promotions Blackburn are in the unusual position of having had no successes to celebrate over the last 40 years or so in the Juniors.

Off Field Success

However by joining the SFA's Pyramid next season and achieving Quality Mark and Community Club accreditation the club has shown ambition. They may not have had much success on the field but the club can boast of significant success off the field.

Blackburn's Good Season

Reaching the Premier League as South Division's runners up last season was a first for the New Murrayfield Park club. They have had as good a

season as they might have expected and are currently level on points with Tayport in fourth top spot. A win here today and they

Blackburn United joined the Junior ranks in 1980 and are the spearhead of what is now the Blackburn United Community Sports Club which was established in 2004 and is now registered as a Charity.

The club was awarded the SFA's Quality Mark and full Community Award in 2009 and has more recently received the SFA's Legacy Award.

Under the Community Club banner, Blackburn United runs a range of under age teams, both male and female.

At their centrally situated football hub, the club can boast a 6 dressing room complex, a floodlit 3G pitch as well as 2 x 11-a-side and 2 x 7-a-side pitches.

Not bad for a town of 5,000 pop.

could well finish 4th on their own. Regardless, Blackburn will take their leave of the Juniors with a highest ever league placing.

Blackburn's league form has been steady if not

spectacular during the season but there have been notable highs including a 4-0 win at Fauldhouse.

...but Form Has Shaded

As the season entered its final stages, Blackburn enjoyed a rich vein of form, winning four league games on the bounce, conceding only one goal in the process, before slipping up in their last two outings, losing to Whitburn and Thornton.

Home Fans In Despair

Tayport's fluctuating form has had their fans in despair in recent weeks, none more so than in the past two weeks when an excellent performance at St Andrews was followed by a shocker at struggling Bathgate.

Hopefully today's display will be more akin to that shown 11 miles down the road two weeks ago than that which went down 2-1 at Creamery Park last Saturday.

The visitors took an early lead, from the penalty spot, before Tulleth netted a fantastic equaliser, sending a wonderful effort over the goalkeeper and into the net, from just inside the opposition's half of the field. As the half wore on, the hosts edged into the lead, when Fraser Anderson delivered a free kick to the far post and **Ryan Suttie** headed home. While 'Port had chances after the break, so did Tranent and they eventually levelled the score, courtesy of centre-half Craig Meikle, who headed in on 84 minutes.

It was disappointing to drop more home points, but the team made amends the following week, when they recorded an emphatic derby win at St. Andrews.
