

Tayport and Fauldhouse - the previous meetings

This will be the seventh meeting between this afternoon's teams. The clubs first got together in April 2007 in an East of Scotland cup tie at Canniepairt which Tayport won by 2-0. It was Frank Conway and Ian Gilzean's first cup tie after replacing Keith Burgess as joint managers two weeks earlier. Tayport went one goal better, winning 3-0 in another EoS tie in March 2014 on Canniepairt.

The first League meetings were in 2009/10, Tayport winning 3-0 at home and drawing 1-1 at Park View.

Tayport's relegation from the Super League in 2015/16 wasn't helped by their games v Fauldhouse. 'Port failed to find the Faulldhouse net that season, losing 2-0 away and 3-0 at home.

Tayport have been busy in the last week making three signings. Midfielder Conor Gray, who played 20 games for 'Port, scoring 2 goals, between January and September 2013 has signed from Lochee United. Forward Jamie Gill (20) has signed on loan from Forfar Athletic until January and at the time of going to print it is expected that Trinidad & Tobago internationalist, striker Richard 'Shaka' Roy (29) who appeared as a substitute last week at Tranent will be fixed up and in this afternoon's squad.

TROM THE ARCHIPES

50 years ago - season 1967/1968.

A Tayport team crashed to what was probably the club's heaviest ever defeat when the club's Alliance XI lost 15-3 away to NCR in a Midlands AFA Lunan Trophy tie. Apparently it was a lot closer than that. Aye, sure!

40 years ago - season 1977/78

On 27th August 1977 Tayport shared the points, drawing 1-1 at home with Kingsway Technical College in a Midlands AFA league game.
