## Today's Game GA Engineering Cup Tayport v Broughty Athletic



Broughty Athletic arrive at Canniepairt this afternoon on the back of an unbeaten Super League run through November with draws v Bo'ness and Bonnyrigg and a win over Sauchie.

The club had a difficult start to the season when their plans for a pre-season friendly down south went awry at the 11th hour. Suffice to say it wasn't the club's finest hour and it prompted the departure of manager Keith Gibson.

Broughty took their time in appointing a successor, before fixing up Kirrie boss Jim Finlayson, an experienced pair of hands who knows the local scene inside out.

Of course, the teams met as recently as the end of last season in the final of this cup at Tannadice when Broughty finished on top and understandably they will be favourites again today. Indeed this is the third successive season that the clubs have been paired in this competition.

The reason why this is the only GA tie in the Region this afternoon is that both clubs have made their exits from the Scottish Cup which elsewhere dominates today's fixture card.

The fact that both clubs have also exited the East of Scotland Cup gives today's encounter greater significance.

Defeat means an exclusive run of league games between now and the end of the season, in Broughty's case 15 games and in Tayport's case 16 games, over the next six months.

Broughty's cup exits this season, to East Craigie and Bathgate Thistle, have come in the cup shock category and no doubt the manager will have instilled in his troops the need to avoid an unwelcome hat-trick this afternoon.

There have been a few additions to the Broughty squad this season and potentially making their first appearances in Broughty's colours against Tayport will be Craig McNaughton (from



Dundee Utd), Chris Liversedge (Coupar Angus),

Kieran McWalter (Montrose), Fraser Smith (Jeanfield), former Scotland defender Garry Kenneth (Douglas), Dayle Robertson (North End), former 'Port striker Kevin Milne (Downfield) and the most recent acquisition, striker Liam McCartney (inset) who joined Broughty this week from East Craigie.

In the opposite camp, Charlie King, Keith Gibson's erstwhile assistant at Whitton Park, will be hoping to have eliminated the profligacy which has seen his side throw away so many points this season.

The Tayport boss is unavailable today so Daryn Smith and Grant Paterson will be in charge at the dugout. and they don't have their problems to seek.

Martin Strachan is cup tied and the experienced trio of Alan Tulloch, Jamie Mackie and Gregor Anderson have all been on the treatment table during the week..

There is the possibility that Tayport could be making a signing so there could be a late addition to the pool.

Today's match runs only to 90 minutes, so if all square, the outcome will be decided by a penalty shootout.





trailing.

Towards half-time, Gregor Anderson had a goal disallowed for offside and Dani Sanchez was denied by the visiting goalkeeper. However, after the break, it was Saints who came out with more conviction and, from a corner kick, Lawrie peeled away to the far side of the area and smashed home a third goal for St. Andrews.

In the 80<sup>th</sup> minute, the hosts reduced the deficit, when Anderson headed in a hanging Craig Sturrock cross, but that was as much as 'Port could muster. Indeed, St. Andrews could have added to their tally, with Lawrie and Jack Wilson spurning good opportunities in the final minutes of what was a disappointing afternoon for everyone in the Tayport camp.

I have many great memories of my time as a player with Broughty, way back in the distant past. The former Celtic and Dundee player Tommmy Mackle (inset) was my first manager. Tommy was a strict disciplinarian insisting the players wore a shirt and tie every game and made sure everyone was in the dressing room at half-time and at the end of the game.



The players who were left out would stand together behind the dugout and he'd occasionally turn and bark out instructions to these guys behind him telling them what he expected from them if they were in the team the next week. When he got irritated he'd say 'you lot must be bad if you can't get in this team'.



Tommy was magnificent in training and would keep me back for extra work. He'd fire in crosses between myself and the keeper and demand both of us to attack the ball with venom. We'd do it until we could do no more. He'd say 'never stop practising until you're the best at it'. There's no doubt in my mind he made me a better striker. Unfortunately for me he was forced to step down because of a family illness. We'd played the first 8 games of the season and won them all. We then proceeded to lose the next eight. The new manager failed in so many ways as did the players. Tommy returned as manager near

the end of that season and, yes, you've guessed, we started winning again. It goes to show just what one man can do to motivate and draw the best out of us.

Last week's home league game turned out to be a huge disappointment. I missed the first 10/15 minutes after which, by all accounts, we could have been 3-0 up. But the parts of the game I did see left me so disappointed. The manager was spot on when he said we are not defending as a team. I agree. We must become a hard side to beat. Right now we are an easy side to beat, that's why I said we need to score two or more to have a chance of victory, disciplined in our shape and our defending has to be from the front. Right now we don't work hard enough when we don't have the ball.

Today is an opportunity to start afresh. Today is the first day of the rest of your life! Good quote! I can't recall who first said it but somewhere along the line we have to learn from our mistakes, so why not today
