Second visit

It's a long time since The Undertakers were here. 24 years in fact, which is the only occasion on which the clubs have previously met.

Recent records not good

Neither side has done too well in the Scottish Cup in recent seasons. Port Glasgow went to the 4th round in 2014/15 and since then have fallen at the first hurdle in the last three seasons. Interestingly, on each occasion it was after a replay.

Tayport's best in recent seasons has also been a 4th round appearance, a defeat at Kilbirnie. Otherwise it's been early exits v Bonnyrigg, Blantyre and Cumbernauld.

On the up

Port Glasgow are currently playing in the West Region's 3rd tier, the McBookie.com League Division One. Three

teams are promoted to the Championship and after a few indifferent seasons, Port Glasgow are confident that this season they can be amongst the serious contenders for that step up.

Earlier this year Port Glasgow made the headlines— not on the football pages but on the news pages of *The Scottish Sun* after the club secured a sponsorship deal with **Eldorado Tonic Wine**.





OVD Scottish Junior Cup 3rd Round

Saturday 3rd December 1994

Tayport 1-0 Port Glasgow Juniors



It was a third successive away tie for the visitors to the Canniepairt that December afternoon in 1994. Port Glasgow, at that time playing in the second tier of the Central Region Juniors, were back on Tayside having beaten the now defunct Elmwood by 4-0 in Dundee in the 1st round. They repeated the scoreline at another defunct club, Bonnybridge Juniors, in round 2.



In round 1 Tayport had won 4-0 at Canniepairt in a replay following a 1-1 draw with Forth Wanderers in Lanarkshire and then won 4-0 at home vs. Balbeggie, also now defunct, in round 2.



When meeting Port Glasgow, Tayport were playing their 25th game of what would be a 36 game unbeaten run stretching from May 1994 to March 1995.

An crowd of 293 saw a solitary goal from ace marksman Dave Reilly ended Port Glasgow's cup run. Reilly would go on to score a record 45 Scottish Junior Cup goals.

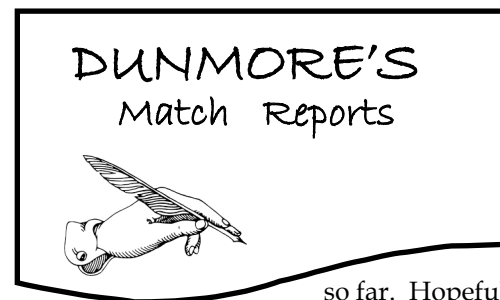


Tayport's team that afternoon was Fraser Mann, Grant Miller, Grant Paterson, Mark Spalding, Andy Sommerville, George Malone, Jimmy Hunter, Gary Maher, Hamish Mackay, Dave Reilly and Jackie Devine. Substitutes were Ewan Cameron and Steven Stewart.



Between them, the players in the Tayport line-up that December afternoon would, during the next few years, go on to make 19 Scottish Junior Cup final appearances between them.

The manager would also go on to do quite well! The Tayport chairman would lead Arbroath FC to promotion, East Fife to the league title and win 3 Scottish Junior Cups with Tayport and Linlithgow Rose

Home form has been good this season, with four Super League wins out of four so far. Hopefully, home advantage will work in Tayport's favour today, although a tough encounter is in prospect.

Against West End, all of the notable action came in the opening quarter of an hour. The first goal came in the fifth minute, when the ball fell kindly for **Chris Liversedge**, who shot past Thain in the visitors' goal, to open the scoring for the hosts.

Shortly afterwards, in the next attack, a **Jamie Gill** (pictured) cross was deflected by defender George and past Thain, to double Port's lead.

The two goal advantage was short-lived, as West End pulled one back on the fifteen-minute mark, when Gill attempted to head a corner clear and unfortunately for him, the ball ended up in his own net.

For the remainder of the contest, there were chances at both ends, but no goals. For instance, the visiting Kemp tested Gavin Sorley with a free kick and also shot wide of the target in the lead-up to half-time.

After the break, Conor Ireland fired over the top for 'Port, while Dayle Robertson hit the side-netting. Towards the end of the encounter, both Batchelor and Ramsey could have levelled, but the Tayport goal remained intact and Charlie King's men claimed the victory.

Let's hope for a good game and a similar outcome in the 'Scottish' this afternoon.

A CHAT WITH CHARLIE



Last week's winning margin maybe flattered FWE a little and gained us a good three points after the disappointing show at Glenrothes. Several players returned to action of course, but what in general do you put the improved performance down to? Anything that particularly pleased you?

Last week's win was pleasing, yes. Having Rollo and Suttie available is big for any team let alone us. Young Struan offering us something too, was great.

You previously mentioned in an earlier CWC that you were still looking at a couple of potential new signings. What areas of your team do you consider you need to strengthen?

Conway trained Wednesday. Luke o' Brien is back in training too. Unfortunately we had Sturrock and Mackie both missing sessions during the week through injury.

With literally the breadth of the country separating the clubs, Port Glasgow are obviously something of an unknown quantity but they seem to have found a bit of form recently. How much do you know about them?

Daryn took the opportunity to watch them last week and made plenty notes. We believe if we turn up, as they say, we have every chance.

That's a year now since you were in charge of your first Scottish tie with Tayport. Briefly, what do you consider has been the high point and the low point of the 12 months in between.

High point is definitely finishing with a better points tally than the previous season and to be promoted, albeit by default.

Low point seems to be consistency and it's getting that settled team on the pitch, even to training to allow us to work more consistently on any negatives.

All in all, we have started this season (for me) a little bit better defensively, more organised all round. We strive continuously to get better.

CHARLIE COOKE –
SURELY THE BEST PLAYER EVER TO HAVE WORN THE
PORT GLASGOW COLOURS ...AND THE TENUOUS
(VERY!) CONNECTION WITH TAYPORT FC

Over the years many famous footballers have cut their teeth at Port Glasgow but none better than Charlie Cooke. Born just a few miles from here in St Monans in Fife's East Neuk, Charlie Cooke (below left), of Aberdeen FC , Dundee FC and of course Chelsea, began his football education with Port Glasgow Juniors before joining Renfrew Juniors from where he signed for Aberdeen in 1960. Charlie then moved to Dundee in December 1964 for £40,000 – then a record fee for a player transfer between Scottish clubs.

That same month, Charlie's arrival at Dens prompted the transfer of striker Bobby Waddell to Blackpool. A member of Dundee's championship side of 1961/62, Deedle netted 43 goals in 84 games for the Dark Blues before moving down south.

Charlie's last game for Dundee was in April 1966 when he moved to Chelsea for £72,500. Earlier that season, a certain Jim McLean had made his debut for Dundee, playing No 11 with Charlie his inside forward at No 10 in Dundee United's momentous 5-0 win over their local rivals at Dens Park.

An injury ended Bobby Waddell's Senior career but he had a successful managerial spell at Tayport before pulling on his boots once again to play for the club's Fife XI in the early
