This afternoon's game is a regional tie in the North/Tayside Inter Regional Cup, a competition which first saw the light of day back in 1989 when it was sponsored by Zamoyski Vodka. Since then it has had many titles having been variously sponsored by Concept Group, The Dugout, North End Centenary, NCR, GA Engineering and now, in their first season of sponsorship, Signature Signs.

#### Tayport's record haul

Tayport have won the competition on a record eight occasions.

Tayport FC recorded their album (The Tayport Boys are) *ON THE PITCH AGAIN* ?

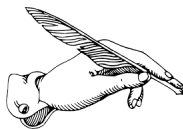

So, 'Port went to Whitburn in fine fettle, but returned pointless. After an uneventful first half-hour, Greg Nicol waltzed through to open the scoring for 'Burn. Both sides had opportunities before half-time, with Whitburn having the majority of them, although Tayport did equalise, courtesy of a Dayle Robertson penalty.

The Central Park men could have added to their tally on quite a few occasions in the second half and eventually did so on 70 minutes, when Liddell scored after a Whitburn break upfield.

With time ebbing away, Jamie Gill headed home a late leveller and it looked like 'Port had stolen a point. Alas, it was not to be, and Martin Russell grabbed Whitburn's winner and 'Port had to face up to another away defeat.
