A Word from our Chairman

Good afternoon to our fans and may I welcome the players and officials of our visitors Kirrie Thistle.

It seems an age since our last home fixture, in fact it was 1st December, some 8 weeks ago, a 4-1 victory over Lochee Harp and we followed that with 3-2 away win to Downfield, both in the Thornton's Property League Cup. The two victories took us to the top of our section, so a victory over Harp would have seen us secure a comfortable position in the section. But it didn't pan out as most people might have thought. We had a 1-0 lead at the interval and but for a few missed opportunities we could have led by a larger scoreline. There was no reason to believe we would falter in the second period, but falter we did. Today Kirrie Thistle are our opponents. We've already faced them on two occasions this season. The league game at Kirrie happened to be my birthday back in August. It didn't happen to be a good birthday. We lost 2-1! But the second encounter was much more pleasing, a 3-0 home victory in the Signature Signs Cup. Let's hope we can see a repeat of that outcome today

Match Report



It seems an age since Tayport's last competitive home game, a Thornton's Property East Region League Cup tie against Lochee Harp, on the 1st December. That match was won comfortably, with 'Port scoring three early goals to set up the first win of the Stevie Kay era. Conor Ireland was on hand to steer the ball home for Tayport's opener, after good work from Jamie Gill. Gill also set up the second goal, when his corner was volleyed home by Ryan Suttie. The lead was further extended, just after the quarter-hour. Gill this time was the scorer, bursting forward and netting from twelve yards out, after the 'keeper had blocked the initial effort. The following weekend, in the same competition, 'Port won by the odd goal in five against old rivals Downfield, avenging an earlier Canniepairt defeat. The on-form Gill scored the opener, with a 40-yard free kick which was fumbled into the net by the 'keeper. The second counter was netted by Jamie Mackie, who was in the right place at the right time to divert a Dayle Robertson header into the net. Calvin Colquhoun netted for the Spiders, shortly before half-time, but, before the break, Jamie Mackie sent a header beyond the 'keeper, to make it 3-1. In the second half, Downfield eventually scored again, courtesy of veteran Bryan Duell, a former Tayport player, but there was to be no Downfield comeback and Tayport had recorded a second successive win.

In terms of the timeline, there then followed a series of postponements and also a festive break from action, so there has been only one match since. It didn't go well. A fortnight ago, again at Downfield Park, Lochee Harp produced an excellent performance to consign 'Port to a 3-1 defeat. Ex-Tayport players did the damage. Lloyd Young, who was with Tayport as a youngster before embarking on his senior career with East Fife, notched a brace of goals, one from the spot, while Connaire Connelly netted a late tap-in. All this after Tayport had opened the scoring, via Dayle Robertson's penalty kick. Oh, and Kieran Conway was ordered off, in what
