Eight wins in last nine

The extent of Tayport's challenge this afternoon can be measured by the fact that Whitburn have won eight of their last nine Super League games and have surged from the bottom of the league after three games to third spot ten games later.

Whitburn find their feet

Whitburn would appear to have been ill prepared for their start in the new Super League set up and there were big defeats at Lochee United and Thornton Hibs before they found their feet.

Five games in, and at Kennoway another defeat beckoned when the home side led with quarter of an hour left. Two goals in the closing minutes secured full points for Whitburn and this win effectively proved to be the turning point in their season.

Never say die

This never-say-die attitude was again evident in the home win over Tayport in our teams' corresponding game earlier this season. Jamie Gill had equalised late on but Michael Russell managed to grab the winner in the 90th minute.

Despite finishing Championship runners-up in the last ever 'old' East Region in 2002, Whitburn elected not to take their place in the new Super League. 16 years later, this season, they finally made it into the top tier, electing not to follow a majority of Lothians based clubs into the East of Scotland League



Whitburn have scored in every league match to date with Gary Brass (pictured) top scorer. However the goals have been spread around with no fewer than

15 different players credited with goals in only 13 league games..

Same squad

Tayport have changed managers since the sides last met and new boss Stevie Kay, is essentially working with pretty much the squad of players he inherited.

With two free weeks at Christmas and four postponements, despite managing to fix up friendlies, Stevie has not seen his side get a lot of competitive action

Six goals in friendly

For goals, Tayport have been relying heavily on Dayle Robertson, one of the Super League's top marksmen, and the manager will have been pleased to see his side put six past Burntisland Shipyard in last Saturday's friendly whilst Dayle was unavailable.

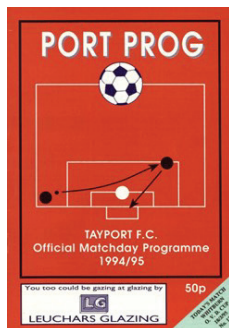

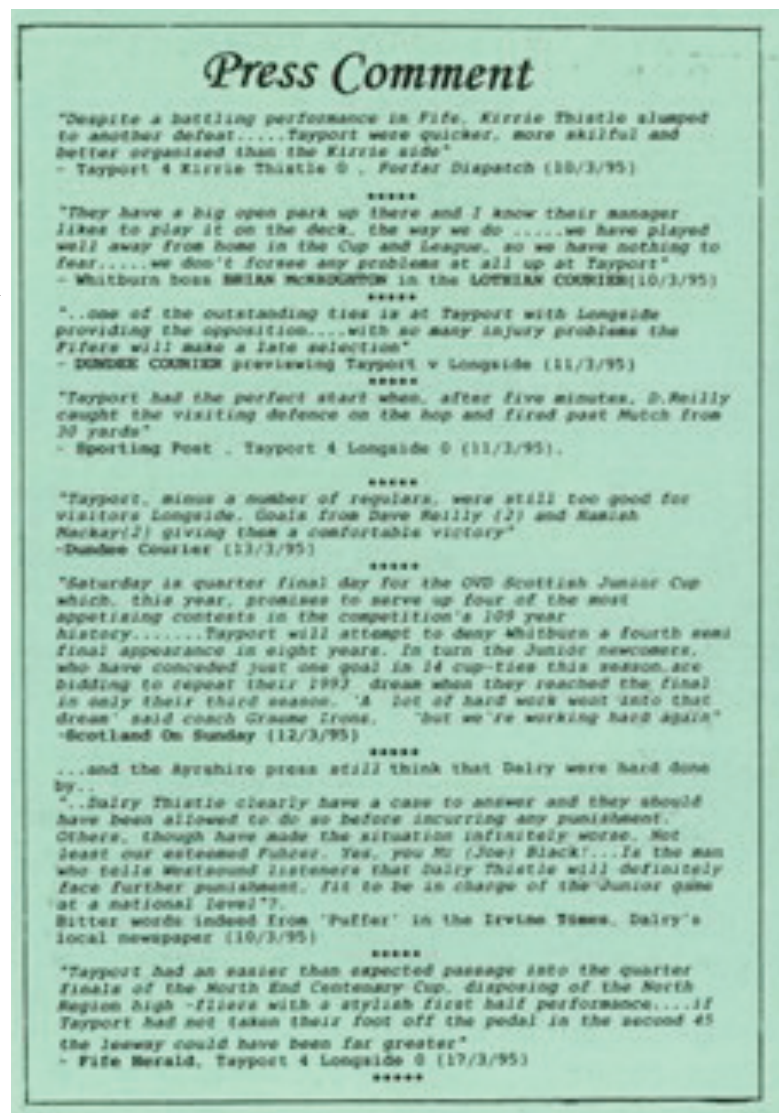

From the Archives - 1995



On 18th March 1995, Whitburn arrived at Canniepairt for the first time to meet Tayport in the Scottish Cup 6th round. The stakes were high with a semi-final place awaiting the winners.

The record books show that a crowd of 892 filed into the Canniepairt that afternoon to see Whitburn win 2-0. Whitburn would go on to defeat Glenafton in the semi final before losing the final 2-0 to Camelon.



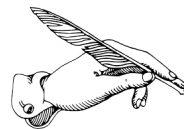
The 'Press Comment' is from the above programme.

The reference to Dalry Thistle concerns Whitburn's 5th round win in Ayrshire which saw the tie awarded to Whitburn. The tie had been abandoned after 80 minutes after five Dalry Thistle players had been shown red cards

Tayport's defeat by Whitburn was their first of the season after a run of 36 games unbeaten.

Undaunted by their loss to Whitburn, Tayport would win their next 16 games on the spin, losing only once in their next 51 games, a run which stretched through to March the following year.

DUNMORE'S Match Report



The stop-start nature of the football card during the winter period remains a frustration for all, as again a whole host of fixtures fell victim to the weather last weekend, including Tayport's game at Kennoway Star Hearts. Instead, a friendly against East of Scotland out-

fit Burntisland Shipyard was hastily arranged and that game took place of the artificial surface at Beath HS. The Shippie opened the scoring, but 'Port were soon level, courtesy of **Kieran Conway**. Before half-time, Tayport's young **trialist** striker had put 'Port ahead and he added another two in the second half, for an impressive hat-trick. **Josh Chalmers** weighed in with two more goals, and missed a penalty, in what became a comprehensive 6-1 victory.

That match will have helped to keep a little momentum going, as 'Port had produced a positive result in their previous fixture. A fortnight ago, Kirrie Thistle visited the Canniepairt on Super League duty and a solid display saw Tayport take a commanding interval lead. The first goal came after only seven minutes, when **Kieran Conway** rose to power home a header, from Jamie Gill's well-delivered corner kick.

The next goal was a cracker. **Dayle Robertson** chased a ball out wide, cut back into the box and sent a curling strike beyond the reach of 'keeper Diamond, to give his side a two-goal cushion.

'Port then had a penalty claim waved away, but, later, when an arm blocked Luke O'Brien's [pictured] volley, the ref did point to the spot. **Robertson** coolly slotted home his second and Tayport's third of the afternoon.



Kirrie had a chance to reduce the leeway just before the break, when the referee chose to award another penalty. Craig Sturrock was the player penalised, harshly, when the ball struck his arm as he slid to block an effort on goal. Former 'Port striker Dale Reid stepped up, but Jack Shaw made a great stop and that effectively sealed the win.

There was no scoring in a second half which 'Port again dominated, but Stevie Kay will have been pleased with the afternoon's work. The gaffer will be hoping for more of the same today, when high-flying Whitburn come to town. They have surged up the table in recent weeks, after posting four wins in a row, so a tough encounter is very much on the cards.

Rhuaridh's joy turns to despair



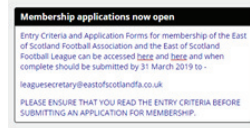

Everybody Touting For Business !



Both the East Region Juniors (ERJFA) and the East of Scotland Football League Seniors (EOSFL) are currently advertising for new clubs.

This season 24 clubs left the ERSJFA to swamp the EOSFL and next season, according to their respective websites, both are offering clubs football at tier 6 of the SFA Pyramid. Yet nobody seems to be exactly sure what the Pyramid set-up in respect of the EOSFL/ERJFA will be next season.

Geographically, Whitburn are in a good place and it wouldn't be a big surprise if they were looking at their options for next season.

Interestingly, the disparity in standards between the [former] EOSL Seniors and the Junior game has been graphically demonstrated by the current placings in the EOSL. Each of the three divisions has eight former Junior clubs and five established EOSL clubs. At present, former Junior clubs hold 16 of the 18 top 6 places.
