A Word from the Chairman

Good afternoon to our support and a warm welcome to the players and officials of Broughty Athletic, our visitors for today's league game.

Since our last Port Prog, we've come up short in all three games. They say league positions don't lie and I'd go along with that. Our three opponents all sit above us in the league table. First was a home reversal to the present league leaders Whitburn, losing 2-1. The frustrating thing is we were ahead in the game and lost a goal in the dying minutes of each half. A warm welcome to our nearest neighbours, Broughty Athletic, from across the river.

Confidence sky high

Broughty are having a fine season, having won nine games on the bounce with not a goal conceded since the beginning of December and scoring an average of 8 goals a game since the turn of the year. To suggest their confidence is sky high would be something of an understatement.

Their biggest disappointment in this season of a depleted Scottish Cup entry will have been the narrow defeat at Hurlford United.

Still in the title race

Domestically Broughty are hanging on the coat tails of Lochee United and every win for the Ferry side maintains the pressure on the title favourites.

Despite shuffling their pack midseason, with several players moving out and a good number coming in, manager Jamie McCunnie has seen his

side maintain their winning momentum.

Broughty's new faces

The manager has introduced strikers Louis Appere and Josh Skelly on loan until the end of the season from Dundee United and Montrose FC respectively.

Broughty Athletic Assistant Manager Steven Fallon had a short – very short - spell at Tayport in 2008 during the equally brief regime of manager Iain Jenkins. The Broughty No. 2 started 3 league cup games in the August of that month before a transfer to St Andrews United

Further additions are midfielders Ryan Ferguson, who was with Montrose FC, Brad Smith (Cowdenbeath FC), Irishman Adam McCracken and goalkeeper Calum Brodie, who has most recently been playing his football in USA. In addition Stewart McConnell has returned from ourselves to Broughty.

Stevie looking to end run

Manager Stevie Kay will be looking to end his side's run of three successive defeats by the odd goal to pull his team away from the perilous position they currently find themselves in.

Josh injury blow

The injury sustained by the in-form Josh Chalmers in the friendly at Kelty was a blow for the Tayport boss. Teenagers Lewis Payne and Kieran Inglis, the latter on loan from Dundee United, have been added to the squad as has youngster Reece Lornie. Struan Christie who broke a leg early in the season is back in light training.

Fraser on loan

Stevie has loaned Fraser Anderson to Arbroath Vics and has made Steven Duffy, Steven Harris and Grant Paterson available for transfer.

Conor Gray and Dale (without the Y) Robertson are back in the squad after a change in work commitments.

Senior Grounds on which Tayport have played

The description 'Senior Ground' no longer means what it used to mean i.e. the home of a Scottish League club. Any ground belonging to a club playing in the East of Scotland League, Lowland League, Highland League etc, I suppose, can be termed a Senior ground but the Senior ground connotation was always one which was the home of what is now an SPFL club.

In the last half century or so Tayport FC have played **competitive** fixtures on eleven different Senior grounds, probably more than most if not all other clubs based in Tayside or Fife. Can you recall the cup ties the club played on these grounds?

Central Park (Cowdenbeath) - Fife Amateur Cup final 1980

Dens Park (Dundee FC) Scottish Amateur Cup semi final 1986

Bayview Park (East Fife) - Skol Cup final 1990

McDiarmid Park (St Johnstone) - PA Cup final 1991

Firhill Stadium, (Partick Thistle) - Scottish Junior Cup semi-finals and finals

Fir Park (Motherwell FC) - Scottish Junior Cup semi-finals and finals

Tony Macaroni Stadium (Livingston) - Scottish Junior Cup semi-final 2002

Broadwood Stadium (Clyde FC) - Scottish Junior Cup semi-final 2003

Starks Park (Raith Rovers) - Scottish Junior Cup semi-final 2004

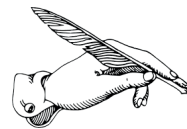
Love Street Paisley (St Mirren) - Scottish Junior Cup semi-final 2005

Tayport, like many clubs has also played many friendly matches on SPFL grounds, particularly those of the Angus based clubs.

Now that many SPFL clubs have artificial surfaces, playing games on an SPFL ground has become run of the mill, with the steady source of income it generates providing a welcome boost to the revenue budget of clubs such as Forfar Athletic and Montrose.

DUNMORE'S Match Report



Tayport's last three matches have been against sides in the top four of the Super League, so a tough set of fixtures, and all three have been narrow defeats. Three weeks ago, on-form Whitburn came to town and 'Port put in a fine first half display. The hosts opened the scoring after 28 minutes, when Chris Liversedge made a trademark run down the left and cut the ball back into the box, where Josh Chalmers coolly controlled it, settled himself and arrowed a shot, low into the far corner of the net.

Other chances came and went and it was Whitburn who scored the next goal, an equaliser towards half-time, when Liddell burst into the box and fired his powerful low shot into the far corner, giving Jack Shaw no chance. 'Burn dominated the second half, but Tayport held firm. Until the last minute! A late corner was swung into a crowded goalmouth, where the ball bobbled around, with Hamilton getting the final touch to force the ball over the line, to spoil Tayport's afternoon.

Next up was a Signature Signs Cup tie against Lochee United, the region's top dogs. In a heartening performance, 'Port opened the scoring, through Dayle Robertson, after a Jamie Gill effort had troubled the home defence. The Bluebells overturned the deficit before the break,

with goals from marksman Conor Birse and former Canniepairt player, Danny Cavanagh. Undaunted, Tayport fought back and, on 57 minutes, Dayle Robertson levelled from the spot, after Jamie Mackie had been flattened by a crowd of defenders. Unfortunately, parity was short-lived and Lochee's Birse netted what would prove to be the winner, with a 63rd minute volley.

Last weekend, it was back to Super League duty and a trip to Thornton's Memorial Park. The first half was even, with 'Port having a decent amount of possession and a few efforts on goal, but a 5 minute spell towards the end of the half left the visitors trailing by two goals. The first came after a long-range free kick came off the bar and was followed up by a couple of Thornton players, then Gary Thomson drilled the ball through a crowd of defenders for his side's second of the afternoon.

In the closing stages of the game, Tayport upped the pressure. Jamie Mackie had an effort ruled out for offside, then he did reduce the lead, with a well-taken volley, after chesting down a Kieran Inglis pass. Despite a couple of near misses, there would be no late leveller, and Hibs held on to collect three vital points.

As we enter this crucial phase of the season, these points are seemingly harder to come by and 'Port have another tough encounter this afternoon, against second-placed Broughty. Let's hope that Tayport can rise to the challenge and post a positive result.

Bluebells see off spirited Ayrshire challenge Troon 0-2 Lochee United

The only change in Lochee's line-up from the previous week's win over Tayport was Logan Davie in for former Tayport and Broughty player Danny Cavanagh.

There had been chances at both ends before Lochee took the lead on the half hour mark through Grant Lawson, another who has previously turned out in the colours of both 'Port and Broughty.

The first half wind and rain relented significantly during the second half as Troon pressed for the equaliser but the Lochee defence held firm and in the last minute Scott McComiskie made sure it would be a happy bus which headed east when he killed off the home challenge with a second goal.

Lochee Fly The Flag

Lochee United are the sole East Region survivors in an otherwise West Region dominated last four. No real surprise, given the host of defectors from the East Juniors to the East of Scotland League. A wholly different story from the 2004 season when the four semi finalists hailed from Tayside and Fife.

Of those clubs which left the Juniors this season, 12 will never have the opportunity to savour the unbridled joy of celebrating a Scottish Junior Cup win.

It's a fifth semi final appearance for the Thomson Park club and a second in successive years but they are still looking for their first cup win and the open top bus trip down the Lochee High Street. Previously Lochee trounced Maryhill to reach the 2005 final but fell at the semi-final hurdle in 1995, 2010 and 2018.

But.....could this be their year?
