A warm welcome to our fellow Fifers, Glenrothes, who are visiting Tayport for the last time as a Junior club, having made the decision to join the East of Scotland FA from next season.

Glens look for good finish

The Warout club is presently foot of the league and they wouldn't want that blot on their history as they leave the Juniors.

Being at the foot of this season's keenly contested East Super League at the moment, doesn't count for a lot as three wins would take Glens soaring up the table.

Indeed a win for the visitors today and full points from their two games in hand would see Glens go level with ourselves with four games to go.

Experience counts

Glens' efforts to haul themselves up the table were boosted significantly with a superb 3-2 win over league leaders Whitburn in their most recent outing,

the goals coming from three of their most experienced campaigners, Gavin Moffat, John Martin and Scott Napier. It was Gavin's first game back after injury and his presence certainly made a

Glenrothes's greatest memory of their time in the Juniors is of **26 April 1975** when they won the Scottish Junior Cup, beating Rutherglen Glencairn 1-0 in front of 17,776 fans at Hampden Park. Glens, who were founded in 1964, had previously lost the 1968 final to Johnstone Burgh. They came close to reaching a third final in 2004 but were denied by Tayport before 3080 at Starks Park.

difference to a defence with the biggest negative goal difference in the league.

Glens may have yet to win on the road in the league this season, scoring only five goals in the process but four of these goals have come in creditable 2-2 draws at Whitburn and Forfar.

Failure to build on lead

A 2-2 draw was also the outcome of Tayport's most recent game at West End's Strathmore Park. Tayport had their chances to put daylight between them and West End but failure to take these opportunities kept West End in contention and in the end they were worthy of their point.

Last Saturday's game at Kennoway, in common with all other games in the ERJFA, was off because of the weather and probably just as well, as injuries and other unavailabilities had decimated 'Port's squad.

Josh and Mati unavailable

Hopefully, matters will have improved in that respect this week, although key midfielder Josh Chalmers is still injured and Mati Zata is on international duty with Zimbabwe Under 23s.

Stephen Duffy and Steven Harris have been transferred to Downfield ahead of the end of March transfer deadline.

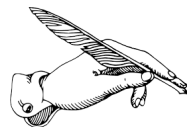

Given last Saturday's weather, there was no real surprise that Tayport's game at Treaton Park, against Kennoway Star Hearts was postponed.

There was something of a surprise on the Canniepairt three weeks ago, however, when 'Port defeated the highly regarded Broughty Athletic by the odd goal in five.

Just six minutes in, Dayle Robertson made life difficult for former Tayport player Gregor Anderson, who was red-carded for a challenge which gave the hosts a penalty. Robertson made no mistake from the spot.

Robertson's persistence led to a second goal five minutes later, when he got the better of the Fed 'keeper.

Midway through the half, Marc Scott halved the deficit, but, undaunted, Tayport soon restored their two-goal lead. Jamie Gill was the instigator and Kieran Inglis, on his home debut, was the scorer of a well-finished counter.

Both teams had chances in the second half, but there would be only one more goal. Broughty's

impressive Louis Appéré, on loan from Dundee United, won a penalty which was converted by Josh Skelly.

Tayport managed to hold onto their advantage and would post a morale-boosting win and collect three valuable points.

Tayport had a good opportunity to follow that result up with another win at Forfar West End, a fortnight ago, but had to settle for a point, after four goals were shared at Strathmore Park.

All the goals came in the first half. The first was scored by the hosts, against the run of play, with Batchelor the marksman.

Jamie Mackie soon equalised, connecting with a deep free kick from Kieran Inglis and, on 27 minutes, a cracker from Kris Rollo edged Stevie Kay's men into the lead.

Unfortunately, Batchelor netted again before the break and it was two apiece.

In the second half, West End went down to ten men and 'Port applied more pressure, but could not find a winner.

Let's hope that Tayport can produce the goods this afternoon, as we enter a crucial phase of the campaign.

PLAYERS REMEMBERED

THE COLOSSUS OF TAYPORT

Paul Daniels, there's a name to conjure with. Jim Scott was also a name to conjure with if you were a Tayport supporter 15 - 20 years ago.

Because of his natural physical attributes Jim's early years were spent at centre half where he performed with some distinction. It was not, however, until Bobby Waddell took over the reigns and realised that a creative but not very combative midfield required a ball winner, that the best of Jim was seen at Tayport.

Now, don't get me wrong, I'm not saying that Jim was a dirty player, just that he did not wear a number on his jersey he wore a Government Health Warning. Opposing players bounced off him as if he were armour plated and his tackles made people on the sidelines wince.

The only flaw in his play was that although he won literally 90% of the balls he competed for, he subsequently gave most of them back in over-ambitious passes. Had he been content merely to lay the ball off after winning it he would have been a world beater.

Scotty was also a boon when the opposition contained an elleged "hard nut", as he always protected his midfield partners and took care of the bampots in his own fashion.

It was not only on the field of play that Jim was a man to be reckoned with, and I well remember a trip to Liege where I was just as in awe of his off-the-field feats. Defying Waddell's early to bed curfew one night, he and Spider McLaren had a contest to see how many different bottles they could take a drink out of in the Kilt bar. Scotty soon left Spider a broken man and went on to have a nip from the lot. With only a couple of hours sleep behind him he was soon heading the ball half the length of the pitch, while Spider tottered around the pitch like a rag doll minus half its stuffing.

Glens' Utopian Dream

Glenrothes have made the bold decision to quit the Juniors at the end of the season and pitch up with the East of Scotland League. Glens' statement (below) cites 'access to the football league pyramid' as a reason for this change. The SJFA clubs have, however, already voted in favour of joining the pyramid system. With regard to the introduction of a youth academy, it's not easy. St Andrews United introduced a similar scheme this season but had to abandon it mid season, nevertheless Glens go with our best wishes

Glenrothes Juniors Club Statement:

The club can confirm that an application has been made to join the East of Scotland League for Season 2019/20 with an SFA Club Licence application to follow soon.

This is not a decision we have taken lightly, however the committee feel it is a progressive move which will ultimately allow us to provide access to the football league pyramid currently in place, if our applications is successful.

We will also be setting up a youth academy from next season at Under 17, under 19 and under 20 level with the under 20's playing in the Lowlands Development League (dependant on application approval)

From a playing perspective this will allow a pathway for the Club's youth teams and an opportunity to play in the Development League and play at a good level within their own local club.

This is an opportunity for the people of Glenrothes to get behind its local football club and be part of the clubs vision moving forward, we will be advertising for new volunteer positions and committee posts in due course to help us drive Glenrothes Football Club forward together.
