Carnoustie General Manager Mark Johnston Puts The Record Straight on Oswald Park (that's a good name)

Unfortunately, I am forced into another clarification of the facts following an article that appeared in this morning's Courier.

The article concerned is regarding the new football pitches at Oswald Park and states that Carnoustie Panmure will move to the new pitch in the summer. The pitches concerned are for the use of the youth sides of Carnoustie Panmure Community FC and not and never have been for Carnoustie Panmure JFC. We are not moving from our home at Laing Park that has been our home for fifteen years.

The article goes on to quote Chairman Phil Hope, Phil is Chairman of the Community Club not ourselves. Later it does state that the 11 a-side pitches will benefit the different age groups but doesn't clarify that it is the Community Club.

I want to re-iterate that we have no intention of moving from Laing Park in fact I would like to announce that we are working towards developing and improving Laing Park with, as a minimum a renewal of the existing facilities but we are also looking at options for providing covered accommodation both standing and seated.

Unfortunately the confusion between ourselves and the Community Club is a problem and has meant that on occasions it has been thought that funding for the Community Club, from sources within the town, has gone to us at Carnoustie Panmure JFC, this is not the case. Former Chairman David Laing retired three years ago, the club has been totally self-funded since then with help from our various sponsorships, Gowfers Gambles and gate receipts. It is a difficult task at times and not helped by confusion and inaccuracies in the media.



FROM THE ARCHIVES EVERYTHING THAT GOES ROUND COMES ROUND

...and that's pretty much where we've got to, following the defection of primarily Lothians and Fife based clubs to the East of Scotland League (EoS). The East Region clubs of the old Tayside League have been something of a victim of their geographical position between the Highland and Lowland and EoS Leagues. The East Region clubs recently voted for a four division set-up next season, with clubs playing each other three times. There will be North and South Super Leagues and North and South Premier Leagues which will fit (somewhere?) into the Scottish Football Pyramid.

A dip into the Archives shows that Tayport had pushed for a restructure back in 1993.



Scepticism prevailed until 2002 and now 17 years later in 2019 we find ourselves back in what is effectively a Tayside League and something like a Forthside League, both under the East Region umbrella.

Last weekend's Fife derby against Glenrothes went Tayport's way, with striker Dayle Robertson (pictured) the star of the show, netting all four of his side's goals in a 4-3 win.

His first came after only three minutes, with 'keeper Mushet beaten by Robertson's low finish.

On 25 minutes, Jamie Mackie sent Robertson racing clear to double the lead, then ten minutes later, in a similar move, Robertson was felled by the visiting Gavin Moffat. Tayport's top scorer stepped up to complete his hat-trick from the spot.



Game over by half-time? Not quite. Other chances were passed up and, just short of the hour, John Martin rounded Jack Shaw and pulled one goal back for the Glens.

With quarter of an hour remaining, Dayle Robertson connected with a ball from Luke O'Brien, to give him his fourth of the afternoon and restore the three goal lead.

Game over? Not quite. The visitors scored twice more, late in the match, but Tayport did manage to hold on to collect three big points.

Another win today would be a big boost, but Carnoustie always provide a stern test, so the Canniepairt men will have to be at their best.

All roads lead to Thomson Park this afternoon, apart from that which runs from Carnoustie to Tayport of course, for the first leg of the Lochee United v Auchinleck Talbot Scottish Junior Cup semi-final.

Despite two World Wars the Scottish Junior Cup is a competition which has had an unbroken run from 1887 and one which has cherished memories for both Tayport FC and Carnoustie Panmure.

Indeed, this is particularly so for Panmure whose solitary success was in a penalty shoot out v Tayport in 2004 after a 0-0 draw, a win which would ultimately deny Tayport the opportunity of becoming one of only two teams to win three cups in a row. Only Auchinleck can boast of that achievement (1986-1988).

Lochee have flirted with success on several occasions but have always fallen at the final or more often, the penultimate hurdle. In the Scottish Junior Cup's 132 year history only one club actually based in the city of Dundee has lifted the trophy, Dundee Violet exactly 90 years ago.

It will not be easy against undisputedly the best Junior side in the country at the moment, especially over two games, but let's hope the Bluebells can continue to fly the flag for Tayside today and give themselves a chance of reaching the final with a scoreline which keeps them in good stead for the second leg next week.
