Andy, who was born and bred in Tayport, played for the Amateurs and was a fervent supporter who served the club throughout my time as manager and beyond. I must say, from a personal point of view, I can't begin to tell you how I felt when I heard the news that Dick Smith had suffered a stroke and sadly didn't recover. This season they beat St Cuthbert Wanderers 7-1 in Preliminary round 1 but lost 1-0 to Broxburn in preliminary round 2

DUNMORE'S Match Report



Tayport and Girvan meet again today, on the Can-niepairt, following last weekend's incredible encounter in Ayrshire.

The sides shared ten goals in a topsy-turvy match and both teams have a chance to finish the job today, with both clearly hoping to continue their goalscoring form, whilst also tightening up at the back. The Canniepairt men perhaps feel that they had the better of the contest, but Girvan too have reason to believe that they can prevail this weekend.

So, to last weekend. Girvan opened the scoring through McClymont, on 17 minutes and the next goal did not come until twenty minutes later, and it was a leveller for Tayport. Dayle Robertson held the ball up for Jamie Mackie and he curled a

great shot into the net from the edge of the area. Before the break, Craig Sturrock conceded a penalty, which was converted by Harvey, so the hosts led at the interval.

Early in the second period,



they extended that advantage, courtesy of another McClymont strike.

Then, the game turned in Tayport's favour. Jamie Mackie reduced the deficit after the goalkeeper had spilled a cross from Struan Christie. Craig Sturrock headed home from a corner, to make it 3-3, with 63 minutes on the clock.

There was still plenty of drama to come!

Jamie Mackie (pictured) became the hat-trick hero, curling home another beauty, to edge Tayport into the lead, for the first time, at 4-3.

In the final quarter of an hour, with some slackness in the Tayport rearguard, goals from Bell and Currie saw Girvan retake the lead and 'Port were again facing elimination.

As injury-time approached, however, Fraser Anderson chipped a ball into the area and Dayle Robertson was on hand to send a glancing header into the net, to earn Tayport an away draw. That said, there was another reprieve for Chris McPherson's side late in the day, when Girvan hit the woodwork in the dying seconds of a thrilling contest.

Let's hope for a similarly entertaining encounter today.

A CHAT WITH MANAGER CHRIS McPHERSON

Tayport had the better share of the play at Girvan and given the chances they created, a five goal return for their efforts wasn't unwarranted. The loss of five goals will have worried you though. What would you put this down to?

I think the players deserve massive credit for their performance on Saturday. It was a long journey and a tough fixture and anyone there as a neutral got their money's worth that's for sure.

Yes we lost five goals, some of which were admittedly avoidable but when you look the squad we had available I think we did remarkably well against a handy Girvan side. You throw the three missing senior players in to the squad for this Saturday and I think this will steady the ship and hopefully shut the door at the back.



Apart from scoring five goals, what positives did you take from the Girvan tie?

There were many positives for me but mainly the heart and desire the boys showed with the never say die attitude that saw us come back from 3-1 down and then eventually equalise in the last minute to bring the tie back to the Canniepairt. I firmly believe that this determination along with a couple of additions to the squad will see us rise up the table before long.

Jordan Garden, Ross Bell and Andreas Patasalides were all left behind on Saturday and now seem to be out of your plans. All three were expected to do a job for you. What went wrong?

I'm not sure anything went wrong if I'm brutally honest. Joe Garden has gone on loan to Dundee Violet to gain match fitness and is still in my thoughts. You can see the quality he has after scoring goals for us in the cup. He just needs match fitness. Ross Bell also did well on his loan period working tirelessly in matches and in training, but more importantly it allowed Fraser Anderson to go the other way and get vital minutes on the pitch. As for young Andreas, he has gone to our feeder team Tayport U/19s and we'll continue to keep an eye on his progress. He is in good hands of their coach Kurt Herd and I expect to see him sign a contract with Dundee FC once his work permit issues are remedied.

On the note of transfers I would expect to see more players join the squad in the near future. As I've touched on before this is an ongoing process due to the time we took on this project and the lads already here will be assisted by new signings but only if they fit the criteria of what we are looking for as we develop the squad.
