

#### Tayport v Forfar West End



Today's adversaries met at Canniepairt as recently as mid September when goals from Liam Godfrey and top scorer Graeme Hart gave the visitors a 2-1 win in the Quest Engineering Cup.

#### On the road for weeks

Since then our opponents today haven't been off the road, this afternoon's encounter being their 7th away game on the trot, a mixture of both cup and league fixtures.

The win at Tayport was followed by a 4-0 win at Scone and a 4-2 win away v Maryhill in Glasgow. After three wins on the bounce it's been 3 defeats in a row, with losses at title aspirants Carnoustie and Broughty Athletic and most recently a 0-3 Scottish Cup reverse at Auchinleck Talbot. No disgrace there of course despite the match report noting that it was a *'routine win for the cup holders against a toothless FWE'*.

#### New backroom staff

New gaffer Derek Lawson, erstwhile manager at Scone Thistle, who took over the reins after West End's Quest Cup tie win at Tayport has appointed his own backroom staff, bringing in Tony McAulay,

This season the East Region supplied only 15 of the 64 clubs who were bidding for a place in the last 32 (4th round) of the Macron Scottish Junior Cup. Of these 15 clubs, 9 made their exit at the 3rd round stage, leaving only **6 clubs from the East Region in the 4th round** which was drawn earlier this week and is scheduled for 23rd November.

Since a host of our League's clubs left East has obviously been watered down. Previously, clubs from the East usually took around half the 4th round places. reached that stage, the same number as



the Junior ranks, the challenge from the Previously, clubs from the East usually In 2016/17, for example, **13 East clubs** in 2006/07.

What about potential winners from the East? Which of our clubs have a chance of lifting the Holy Grail of the Junior game? Kirrie showed the way in the last round by eliminating Largs Thistle, last season's beaten finalists and currently near the top of the West Superleague. Most of the East Region six, given a couple of breaks, will fancy their chances of going all the way. History is not on their side though, for only one of the six - Tayport - have previously gone all the way. But, as Henry Ford reputedly said 'History is bunk'.

### DUNMORE'S Match Report



through by the odd goal in nine!

Tayport are in league action today, after several weeks of cup tie action and a couple of postponements. At the start of last month, Girvan visited the Canniepairt for a Scottish Junior Cup replay, the sides having shared ten goals in an incredible first encounter in Ayrshire.

In the replay, there was no repeat of the goal rush, but Tayport looked the more dangerous team. They didn't really up the ante until the final quarter of the game, though. Luke O'Brien came mighty close to a breakthrough when he crashed a shot off the bar on 66 minutes. Then, the introduction of substitutes Lyall Shaw and Tom Whyte helped end the visitors' resistance. Shaw sent Jamie Gill down the left and, after Christie failed to convert the cross, Whyte was on the spot to lash the ball high into the net past 'keeper Brown with his first touch of the game.

Girvan's hopes of a comeback took a blow a minute later, when Harvey saw red for a second caution. Then, on 77 minutes, Dayle Robertson made the tie safe, when he cleverly lofted the ball over Brown for the second home goal of the afternoon.

Having successfully negotiated

that match, next up was a trip to Armadale, in the East Region Cup. And what took place there was another cup cracker, with 'Port ending

Armadale netted first, on 25 minutes, but Jamie Mackie brought Tayport level with a fine free kick. 'Dale edged back into the lead, courtesy of a goal from Goss and could have extended that lead, but Jack Shaw managed to save a Goss penalty, before the break.

Tayport then came storming back. Lyall Shaw scored his first goal for the club on 58 minutes and a Dayle Robertson brace put the visitors 4-2 up and in a commanding position. However, counters by Hay and Sampson brought the hosts a level, at four apiece and a penalty shoot-out was looming.

Dayle Robertson had other ideas though and his hat-trick goal put Tayport through to the next round.

The North Superleague game at home to Downfield was postponed due to an unplayable Canniepairt surface, but the following week, 'Port met the Spiders on Scottish Junior Cup business.

Again, Tayport would win a cup cracker. A goal from Lee Cameron saw Downfield lead at the break, but Dayle Robertson equalised early in the second period, with Jamie Mackie the provider.

The Spiders soon edged back into the lead, courtesy of Ryan Hunter, son of Tayport great, Jimmy Hunter. The hosts looked like they had extended the lead still further, when Kerr Hay's penalty found the top corner. However, Kerr had slipped at the point of contact and eagle-eyed officials spotted a double-hit and the goal was disallowed.

Tayport then took over, for a while. Dayle Robertson tied the game at 2-2, just past the hour, then netted his hat-trick after a Luke O'Brien effort had crashed against the bar.

By 76 minutes, it was 4-2. Robertson, who is in imperious goalscoring form, was again handily placed to score after Jamie Gill's shot had come off the post.

Game over? Not quite. There was still time for Jack Shaw to save a home penalty, to preserve the two-goal cushion and for Cameron to reduce that leeway to set up a nervy conclusion to the match. Two Downfield players, as well as Tayport's Lyall Shaw, were ordered off late in the day and Chris McPherson's side did enough to put their name into the hat for this week's fourth round draw.

Last week, the game at Kirrie was postponed, in common with all of the region's league fixtures, so this weekend represents the first opportunity since September for Tayport to claim some Superleague points.

Let's hope for more goal-scoring form this afternoon, when Forfar West End come to town.


## A CHAT WITH MANAGER CHRIS McPHERSON
