



DUNMORE'S Match Report



Tayport are in league action today, after several weeks of cup tie action and a couple of postponements. At the start of last month, Girvan visited the Canniepairt for a Scottish Junior Cup replay, the sides having shared ten goals in an incredible first encounter in Avrshire.

In the replay, there was no repeat of the goal rush, but Tavport looked the more dangerous team. They didn't really up the ante until the final quarter of the game, though, Luke O'Brien came mighty close to a breakthrough when he crashed a shot off the bar on 66 minutes. Then, the introduction of substitutes Lyall Shaw and Tom Whyte helped end the visitors' resistance. Shaw sent Jamie Gill down the left and. after Christie failed to convert the cross, Whyte was on the spot to lash the ball high into the net past 'keeper Brown with his first touch of the game.

Girvan's hopes of a comeback took a blow a minute later, when Harvey saw red for a second caution. Then, on 77 minutes, Dayle Robertson made the tie safe, when he cleverly lofted the ball over Brown for the second home goal of the afternoon.

Armadale netted first, on 25 minutes, but Jamie Mackie brought Tayport level with a fine free kick. 'Dale edged back into the lead, courtesy of a goal from Goss and could have extended that lead, but Jack Shaw managed to save a Goss penalty, before the break.

Tayport then came storming back. Lyall Shaw scored his first goal for the club on 58 minutes and a Dayle Robertson brace put the visitors 4-2 up and in a commanding position.

However, counters by Hay and Sampson brought the hosts level, at four apiece and a penalty shoot-out was looming.

Dayle Robertson had other ideas though and his hat-trick goal put Tayport through to the next round.

The North Superleague game at home to Downfield was post-poned due to an unplayable Canniepairt surface, but the following week, 'Port met the Spiders on Scottish Junior Cup business.

Again, Tayport would win a cup cracker. A goal from Lee Cameron saw Downfield lead at the break, but Dayle Robertson equalised early in the second period, with Jamie Mackie the provider.

The Spiders soon edged back into the lead, courtesy of Ryan Hunter, son of Tayport great, Jimmy Hunter. The hosts looked like they had extended the lead still further, when Kerr Hay's penalty found the top corner. However, Kerr had slipped at the point of contact and eagle-eyed officials spotted a double-hit and the goal was disallowed.

Tayport then took over, for a while. Dayle Robertson tied the game at 2-2, just past the hour, then netted his hat-trick after a Luke O'Brien effort had crashed against the bar.

By 76 minutes, it was 4-2. Robertson, who is in imperious goalscoring form, was again handily placed to score after Jamie Gill's shot had come off the post.

Game over? Not quite. There was still time for Jack Shaw to save a home penalty, to preserve the two-goal cushion and for Cameron to reduce that leeway to set up a nervy conclusion to the match. Two Downfield players, as well as Tayport's Lyall Shaw, were ordered off late in the day and Chris McPherson's side did enough to put their name into the hat for this week's fourth round draw.

Last week, the game at Kirrie was postponed, in common with all of the region's league fixtures, so this weekend represents the first opportunity since September for Tayport to claim some Superleague points.

Let's hope for more goal-scoring form this afternoon, when Forfar West End come to town.





A CHAT WITH MANAGER CHRIS McPHERSON

The talking point amongst fans is understandably the last three away games. Fourteen goals scored but twelve conceded, yet unbeaten in all three, your thoughts on how we stop haemorrhaging goals?

Yes, that's what the statistics will reflect, however these games were typical cup ties, end to end stuff, we were up against it at times for reasons that I won't go into but there have been a few penalties against us, so I'm delighted the



boys have rolled their sleeves up, shown character in abundance and ultimately ensured we got in the hat for the next round. The goals against column is something we'll improve on and over the piece I'm very happy with our defence in recent weeks.

Two games ago at Armadale, Lyall Shaw became the twelfth new start this season. He was involved in a goal on his debut as sub against Girvan and netted on his first start two weeks later v Downfield. You signed him from Crossgates Primrose. Can you tell us your thoughts behind that move.

Lyall has been someone that we have specifically identified to come in and improve our team and overall squad. I've played against him in the old Superleague and he caused my team a number of problems with his skill, directness and low centre of gravity which makes him a nightmare for defenders to mark. I think you've seen from his first three appearances that he has a lot to offer, has a fair bit of experience and is exactly the standard of player we're looking to bring into the squad. I've also really been impressed with his attitude, he is keen to work hard and travels a fair distance to come to training, so I'm delighted with our acquisition.
