A WORD FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Carnoustie Panmure provide our opposition this afternoon, a warm welcome to both their players and officials and can I also welcome our own support.





Sad, but that's life in 2020.

DUNMORE'S Match Report



It's back to Superleague action for Tayport today, their thirtieth campaign in the Scottish Junior Cup having ended last Saturday, at the hands of holders Auchinleck Talbot. While disappointed to have exited the national competition, the team should be greatly encouraged at having run Auchinleck so close on their own turf. In front of, by far, the largest crowd to have watched Tayport this season, 'Bot caught their visitors cold by opening the scoring after only twenty seconds of the Beechwood Park encounter. A ball into the box, from the right-back area, caused problems for the visiting rearguard and there was something of a fankle, as the ball broke for striker Boylan, who had the

Both sides had chances during the rest of the half, with the hosts twice hitting the woodwork. 'Port were competing well though and they deservedly equalised on 75 minutes, when Kris Rollo swept home a dangerous

simple task of rolling it into an

empty net.

Lyall Shaw corner kick. Now there was real belief that the north-east Fifers could at

least force a replay. In fact, there was even a chance to win it. Jamie Gill found Dayle Robertson, eight yards out, and he sent a first-time shot goalwards, only for giant 'keeper Andy Leishman to produce an outstanding reflex save to keep Robertson at bay.

Even more galling was that Hyslop netted a headed winner for Auchinleck, in the dying moments of what had been a cracking cup tie, between the two sides who have had the most appearances in the final of the Scottish Junior Cup over the past thirty years. This match was at the fifth round stage and was a defeat, but it was still a game to remember.

Prior to that match, Tayport's previous game had been a league encounter, at home to Kirrie Thistle. On that occasion, a five-star show saw 'Port record an emphatic win. Dundee FC loanee Danny Strachan made his debut, at right-back, and another teenager, Kyle Middleton, was given his first start of the

season. Dayle Robertson claimed another hat-trick but the man of the match was Lyall Shaw who set up four of the Tayport goals.

The first counter was scored by Greg Whyte, who gave the 'keeper no chance with an exquisite free kick. Next up was Robertson's first of the afternoon. Strachan set Shaw down the right and he delivered the perfect cross for Robertson to make it 2-0.

Two goals in two minutes before the break saw Robertson net from Shaw's cross for number three and, right on the whistle, Ryan Suttie sent Shaw clear. His cross found Jamie Gill coming in from the left to blast home his side's fourth goal.

Tayport lost 'keeper Jack Shaw through injury midway through the second half, just before Robertson completed his hat-trick with a fine volley from Shaw's cross from the left, to round of a 5-0 victory.

So, there is much cause for optimism within the Tayport ranks, although Carnoustie will provide stern opposition this afternoon.







A CHAT WITH MANAGER CHRIS McPHERSON

Your team did you proud on Saturday and came within a whisker of getting, at the least, a replay. What in particular pleased you and were there any areas you felt we could have improved upon in Saturday's performance?

I was extremely proud of the performance that the boys put in on Saturday. Week on week we've been showing progress. My management team and I aren't ones to praise defeat, however Saturday was our best performance of the season. I think the feedback from the opposition says it all. They said it was the toughest game of their season so far and that we have a fine young and enthusiastic team, who gave the game a real go. The



Auchinleck manager and committee said they are used to teams trying to play defensively against them and that they were impressed with our energy and fitness levels. I think our shape has dramatically improved and every player knows what is expected of them. To have fielded almost the same team for the last few games has definitely helped the boys improve collectively.

Young Danny Strachan, on loan from Dundee, has certainly looked the part in his first two games. Any more surprises up your sleeve?

Yes we are grateful to Dundee FC and in particular Scott Robertson for loaning us young Danny. He has shown maturity beyond his years since coming in and I know Dundee have high hopes for him. There has been a fair bit of movement in the squad lately with two long serving players moving on and we wish them well at their new clubs. Player recruitment is an ongoing process and I have one eye on next season as well as signing players to improve the squad for this season. All I'll say is that we have had a foreign player on trial in the last week and we are looking to tie up a short term deal for him in the near future. With any luck he'll be in the squad for the Carnoustie game.

With the Scottish Cup now a memory, the league position will be our main focus. Recent wins have been against sides in the bottom half of the league and it'll no doubt be a stiffer challenge against the league leaders this afternoon. What are your thoughts on today's game?

Yes, my old club Carnoustie are the form team in the league and to be fair as far as I'm concerned, deserve to be top of the table. It'll be a tall order for us trying to match up against such a quality side but our players are quietly determined to put right a few wrongs having suffered a heavy defeat the last time that we met. Needless to say, with it being a home game, we'll be going out to compete as best as we can and if possible take all three points.
