Surely Tayport will be out to erase the memory of last Saturday. To do so, they will have to put the hems on Frankie Devine and our former striker, the veteran Gary Sutherland, both of whom have been amongst the goals since the turn of the year.

Tayport have struggled this season against the division's pace setters, Carnoustie, Broughty and Lochee United but our improved form in the league can be measured by the performance and result against North End this afternoon

Ryan Suttie should be back and it's likely that Liam McCartney will feature against his old club at some point while Alejandro Cabrera could get his first taste of Canniepairt action.

## Tayport Football Club In Conjunction with The Community



Hello, my name is David Baikie, Chairman of Tayport Football Club.

We are about to embark on a proposal to secure the Canniepairt on a long term lease (99years) from Fife Council.

This will require a significant upfront cost based on the current value of the ground. Fife Council has valued the ground at £65,000 (SIXTY FIVE THOUSAND POUNDS) + VAT. However this figure can be significantly reduced if the club can demonstrate how the wider community benefits from the Football Club facilities and various community activities.

We are conducting a survey of residents and groups/associations to help us learn more about our community needs and how we as a Football Club can expand our current offering to our local Community.

The information will be used in our bid to secure the ground on a long term lease.

## DUNMORE'S Match Report



It seems like an age since the last home game, a narrow defeat against table-topping Carnoustie Panmure, on the 1<sup>st</sup> February. The Gowfers have been the form team in the Superleague, so, while always disappointing to lose, Tayport did put in a creditable performance. The hosts probably had the better of the first half, without there being too many chances during that period. After the break, it was the visitors who exerted more control and substitute Martin headed home their winner, in the 74<sup>th</sup> minute, following a cross from former Tayport player Steven McPhee. 'Port ended the match with ten men, after Ryan Suttie was ordered off, for a second caution, late in the game.

The next week, the Canniepairt men got back to winning ways, when they posted a 3-1 victory at Kirrie's Westview Park. They had to come from behind though, as Ryan Winter netted Kirrie's opener, with a low shot past Jack Shaw, after only six minutes. Two headers saw Tayport soon overturn that deficit, with Lyall Shaw (pictured) the provider of both, thanks to his dangerous set-piece deliveries. On 8 minutes, Jamie Gill netted the leveller and, on 20 minutes, Craig Sturrock edged

his side into the lead. During the course of the match, Kirrie were having plenty of the ball, but the better chances were falling to Chris McPherson's team and they

scored the all-important next goal, in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute. Dayle Robertson started the game on the bench, but he netted within twelve minutes of his introduction to the fray, when he collected a pass from Jamie Gill and sent a precise finish into the net, to make it 3-1.

The result was a major boost for 'Port, who have now moved clear of the relegation spots. Although there is still a long way to go in the battle to avoid the drop, Tayport do seem to be on an upward trajectory. The postponement of the Forfar West End fixture was, therefore, frustrating, as it would have been a crucial fixture, in terms of league placings. The home cup tie against Scone, scheduled for 22<sup>nd</sup> February, was also postponed and when Tayport were next in action, they suffered a cup defeat against second tier East Craigie. To be fair, the Shipbuilders will not be second tier for long, as they are well on course for promotion to the top flight.

Although Lyall Shaw hit the post in the opening minutes, an early penalty gave East Craigie the lead, and attacker Adam Brown doubled his and his team's tally on the 25 minute mark. So, 'Port trailed by two at the break.



The

intro-

duction of Jamie Mackie and Dayle Robertson, from the bench, provided a much-needed boost and it was not long before both players made their mark. Mackie was on hand to blast home at the far post, following a corner kick, to reduce the leeway, five minutes into the second half. Robertson then played his part in the leveller, his shot hitting the post and appearing to cannon off a defender and into the net.

Hopes of a complete turnaround were dashed in the final quarter of an hour, when the hosts were awarded their second penalty kick of the afternoon, as MacLeod took a tumble inside the area. East Craigie substitute Howett netted from the spot, giving the energetic home team a first victory over the Canniepairt outfit.

Today, it's a return to league duty, for the second home fixture against North End. Let's hope for a better result than we had back in August, when the Dokens last came to town.



## A CHAT WITH MANAGER CHRIS McPHERSON

**You left Dayle out from the start at Kirrie and against East Craigie last week. What was your thinking behind these team selections?**

Dayle had a week away with the Scottish futsal team and now that we have the makings of a good squad we are able to rotate and give other players a chance to impress. I think it's important that the players have stiff competition in every position and they know that they have to perform consistently to a high standard to keep their place in the team.



**Still on Robertson, you've released Dale of that ilk from his contract. Apart from the bonus of there being less confusion for the punters and the press, how confident are you that we have enough cover in that area.**

Dale has been a great servant to the club and a fantastic professional throughout his career. He has played well when called upon this season but of late he has found himself behind Craig Sturrock and Fraser Wilson for a starting berth. He decided to take a step back from the playing side in order to spend time with his family and that is a decision that we reluctantly accept but ultimately respect.

**You've signed a Spanish player. What can you tell us about him?**

Yes we've signed Alex Cabrera who is a young Spanish striker who has played at a senior level in Spain. From training he has a fantastic touch, lots of pace and has a trick or two up his sleeve. I'm sure he is a player that will excite the Tayport fans during the upcoming fixtures.

**After Kirrie you'd no doubt be disappointed with the East Craigie result. Can you put your finger on what went wrong there?**

It's hard to put your finger on any one reason why we failed to perform to the levels expected against East Craigie. We just weren't at it. I look at the fact we hadn't had a competitive game for three weeks, and that the pitch was heavy. I've also been reminded that East Craigie have beaten Carnoustie, Lochee United and Broughty in recent times, but for me, we just didn't reach the standards that we reached in recent league games. We're all disappointed to be out the cup but I have to look at the bigger picture and point out how this set of players have performed in recent weeks and months winning 5 out of 7 league games. Anyone can have a bad day at the office and I'm willing to give the boys the benefit of the doubt on this occasion. Ultimately we lost to two soft penalties so it's important we keep things in perspective.

**North End today and an opportunity to erase the memory of that earlier home defeat back in August. Your thoughts on today's game?**

We will be determined to make up for what was a heavy defeat earlier in the season. Tony McAulay (North End manager) has an excellent squad to choose from, however we are in a far better place now than we were when we first played them. We know it will be a tough test but like any home game, we'll be looking to take all three points in order to progress up the table.
