TODAY'S GAME MIDLANDS LEAGUE TAYPORT v COUPAR ANGUS



A warm welcome to our Perthshire visitors whose visits to the Canniepairt over the past 33 years have been scarce to say the least. Coupar first came calling in November 2002 and were beaten 8-1 in the 1st round as Tayport took the first step along the way to lifting their second Scottish Cup. In October 2013, it was 4-0 in the GA North/Tayside Cup and last season, in only a 3rd visit in four decades, it was 6-0 in the first ever League meeting of the sides.

The fact that this is only the second league encounter between today's teams, despite both always being members of the same association, is down to the fact that the clubs had always been in different divisions.

All change now of course, not only are the two clubs in the same division, but Coupar's seemingly perenial end of season position near the bottom of the league could be over, following an injection of new blood which, after a sticky start to the season, has seen has seen results improve.

This can be illustrated by their 1-1 draw at present League leaders Broughty Athletic earlier this season while their defeat by Lochee United

last Saturday was only their third loss in their previous ten games.

One familiar face in the Coupar squad is Connaire Connelly who had four seasons at Canniepairt, making 53 appearances. Dominic Blair will be missing through suspension.

For goals, Coupar will be looking to Sean Tucker who has four goals in his last four matches. Coupar have scored in each of their last ten games so expect them to find the net today

Scoring goals at home has been manager McKenzie's headache, the strike rate of five goals in their last six home games is a conundrum the Tayport boss is desperately keen to solve.

Greg McColm will be back for Tayport following his suspension and there could be a starting place for loan signing Bruno Debembe who looked lively in his 20 minute cameo at Brechin last week.

So, an interesting game today. Will Coupar maintain their goalscoring run? Will Tayport find the road to goal and in so doing maintain their 100% home record v Coupar. We should have these answers around 4.15 this afternoon.

Last weekend's Quest East/North Regional Cup

Last weekend we were in league action against Brechin Victoria but for many teams in the league, it was cup weekend. Seven East Region Midlands League clubs were in action in the Quest Engineering Cup, which we got to the final of last year, but sadly after being knocked out by Broughty Athletic in the second round of this year's competition in December, there was to be no repeat of last year's cup run for us.

The team that beat us in last year's final, East Craigie, are in the third round of the competition and they are in action today, after being occupied by their Scottish Junior Cup quarter-final last weekend. They take on Sunnybank today in the third round of the Quest Cup and you would predict them to advance in that competition. If they do advance to the next round, that will mean six of the eight teams in the quarter-finals are from the Midlands League with only two being from the North Region. This is a pattern since the competition was inaugurated 34 years ago, with only two North teams getting their name on the Cup, whereas there are around a dozen Tayside names, Tayport taking up most space with eight wins.

Glentanar won against Dundee Violet in what sounded like an exciting match at Glenesk Park, winning on penalties after the match ended 3-3. The other team from the North to advance was Hermes, currently, second in the North Premier league, who according to reports, comfortably beat Kirrie Thistle 2-0. The other five winners were Carnoustie, who overcame a battling Bridge of Don Thistle by 3-2, Downfield who edged Maud 1-0 and Lochee Harp who perhaps somewhat surprisingly beat Rothie Rovers, 2-1, and will be delighted to still be in the competition after a challenging month, where they have lost to Brechin Victoria and Dundee St James at the bottom of the league. There were comfortable wins for Dundee North End, who beat Stonehaven 3-0, and Broughty Athletic who thrashed Islavale 6-0.

Last year in this cup the Midlands League teams dominated and it looks like it's going to be the same this year, an indicates that the Midlands League teams seem to currently be at a higher level than teams in the North Region. But it's important to remember that on paper it would appear that teams from the top league in the West of Scotland and the East of Scotland are at a higher level than teams in the Midlands League. But as we have seen from Darvel this year, on the day, anyone can beat anyone regardless of level or tier. It was disappointing not to be involved in the Quest Cup last weekend but as we know, this is very much a transitional season for the club as Daryl builds his squad for the future and hopefully, it won't be too long till we are reaching cup finals again.

Before their biggest crown in modern times, Craigie took an early lead through Chris Mudie and looked to take the advantage into the break but a penalty kick brought North Lanarkshire club level.

Shotts looked livelier in the second half and had the ball in the net but a linesman's flag came to Craigie's rescue, with the goal ruled out for offside. Further drama with 20 minutes left when the home team was reduced to 10 men, former Tayport player Andy McDonald (right) collecting a second yellow card.

The visitors might have sensed an opportunity to cash in on their one man advantage but it wasn't to be and it would be Craigie's day when Rory Faulkner grabbed the winner in the dying minutes.

Quest Tayside/North Region Cup





Interestingly, that XI never actually played together for 'Dee.
