out 3-1 victors.



### 1994 FROM THE ARCHIVES 1994

On 24 December 1994 Tayport were at home to North End in a Tayside League fixture which attracted an attendance of 317 to The Canniepairt to witness a 3-1 win. The win would extend Tayport's unbeaten run from the middle of May the previous season to 28 games to which another 16 would be added before Whitburn came to town in March to win 2-0 in the 6th round of the Scottish Cup. Thereafter, Tayport would go unbeaten in a further 14 games stretching to the end of May 1995.

A look at the line-up which accounted for the Dokens would leave no doubts as to why the team was enjoying such success. What a star studded line-up it was: Fraser Mann, Grant Miller, Grant Paterson, Mark Spalding, Andy Sommerville, Sean Wilkie, Gary Maher, Steven Stewart, Hamish Mackay, Dave Reilly, Ewan Cameron. On the bench were Jimmy Hunter (whose young lad Ryan will be in the Broughty line-up today) and Mike Gray. Hamish Mackay, a rare goal from Grant Paterson and an own goal counted for Tayport

# TODAY'S GAME TAYPORT v BROUGHTY ATHLETIC



#### **MIDLANDS LEAGUE**

Broughty Athletic arrive here this afternoon currently four points ahead of the Championship chasing pack. However, with our two games in hand. we are potentially only one point behind them. The outcome today is therefore very important for both sides.

Since losing to Downfield on November 9th, Broughty have won their last 4 league fixtures, scoring 29 goals in the process for the loss of only two. Their goals in these four games have been spread amongst 11 different players but leading their scoring charts with 20 goals already this season, is former Scotland Under 16 International cap Darren Watson (pictured).



21 year old Darren moved from school in Fife to the SFA's Performance School programme at St John's HS in Dundee and a contract with Dundee United, making his debut v Rang-

ers in a Premiership match. He has since had SPFL League experience at Forfar Athletic and East Fife before settling at Broughty.

Since making the number 1 spot his own back in September, Tayport keeper Fraser Burnett faces his former side today and will be anxious to do his bit to help his team extend their superb run of 10 successive league wins during which time Fraser has lost only four goals.

Whilst Broughty have chalked up six clean sheets at home, away from home, they haven't managed to deny

their opponents a goal since the first game of the season in August.

It's a return to Canniepairt for Broughty boss Darren Scott, signed back in 2008 by then Tayport manager Ian Gilzean.

George Shields was pleased with the opportunity of a friendly last Saturday after the Kirrie game had been postponed. His squad had a good workout, so he should be spoiled for choice this week. It's one thing collecting points from the bottom half of the League but it's a different story against the teams in the top half dozen or so.

This, therefore will be a test today as the year draws to a close and we look forward to the league split, probably at the end of January

#### **Match Report**

### Midlands League 7 December 2024 at Victoria Park Brechin Vics 0-2 Tayport

On an afternoon when Storm Darragh caused widespread postponements throughout the uk, the Midlands League managed a full league programme. Ironically, Tayport were at Victoria Park Brechin, Vics ground, which is situated in the heart of the area of the Angus city which was devastated by floods exactly a year earlier during Storm Babet.

Tayport chalked up their sixth successive victory on the road with their fifth 2-0 scoreline of the season and showed only one change from the side which started at Coupar Angus, Scott McComiskie replacing the unavailable Nick Mann up front.

Tayport completely dominated the first half and were well worth their two goal lead. James Simpson, up for a corner, knocked home a loose ball from close range for the first in 17 minutes and the second, five minutes from half time, was from a perfectly executed penalty from Jamie Crowe after Ethan Samson had been flattened in the box. It was a different Vics in the second period, and that was perhaps because it was a different 'Port. The home side had more of the ball but like their visitors, rarely threatened their opponents goal. It wasn't to be Vics day, though, as the two chances they did have, resulted in misses with the goal at their mercy.


### Midlands League 30 November 2024 at Foxhall Park Coupar Angus 1-4 Tayport

Gordon Norrie pulled back a goal for the locals early in the second period but Jamie Crowe, skipper in Jamie Hume's absence, regained his side's lead, heading a third from Kieran Crighton's cross before sub Scott McComiskie quickly netted a fourth from Ethan's cross to ensure a comfortable closing fifteen minutes


