TODAY'S GAME TAYPORT v LETHAM MIDLANDS CHAMPIONSHIP PHASE TWO GAME 7/9



We welcome Letham to Tayport this afternoon for only their fourth visit to the Caniepairt and in total, what will be only the eighth meeting between the clubs.

First meeting was in September 2021 when Tayport scraped a 3-2 win here. Tayport have won all previous meetings and until our 3-1 win in Perth earlier this season, all these wins could also have been described as having been 'scraped'. In 2020/21, it was 3-2, both home and away, 2021-22, 1-0 both home and away and in 2023/24, also both 3-2, home and away.

Despite a recent disappointing run, Letham will have been reasonably pleased with their season. Following that 3-1 defeat by ourselves back in November, the Seven Acres club embarked on a seven game unbeaten run in December and January, rattling in 27 goals in the process. This success ensured a place in the top ten following the League split.

Letham got off to a good start in the second phase, sharing six goals with Lochee Harp in their first game. Thereafter the goals - and the points - dried up, losing successive league games 3-0, 4-0 and 5-0 to Lochee United, North End and Broughty Athletic, with a 3-1 cup defeat by Ellon United sandwiched in between.

However the green shoots of recovery seemed to have appeared last week at home to East Craigie when Letham led 2-0 through two Aiden Strong goals before letting Craigie back in to turn the tables and win 3-2.

At the end of March, team manager Sean Whitworth Pert (right) stepped down, citing family and work commitments. Having overseen the club's graduation from the amateur game to this season's top ten finish in the Midlands Junior League, Sean, who was now making a 120 mile round trip for games, left with a glowing testimonial from the Letham committee, players and supporters.

New signing Nathaniel Nwosu will again be in Tayport's goal, replacing the injured Fraser Burnett. In addition, manager Shields will be without regulars, Hume, McComiskie and James Simpson. Veterans Andy Ballantine and coach Gary Sutherland will be pulling on a strip to help populate the bench as Tayport look for a strong finish to the league season which could give them an outside chance of finishing third.



PAUL BERG of TAYPORT FC WALKING FOOTBALL CLUB REPORTS...

Although we are self-financing, we appreciate the backing and support the club gives us, including as an example, a regular page in the Matchday programme. Our aim is to carry on in the same way, attracting new members and being not just a successful walking football club, but a social club as well.

Match Report

Midland Championship Phase 2 6/9

5 April 2025 at Canniepairt

Tayport 1 - 0 Lochee United

A deserved three points to complete the league double over the Bluebells and a much improved performance all round. Main talking point amongst the Canniepairt faithful was the introduction of a new goalkeeper, the giant figure of Nigerian Nathan Ikechukwu for whom Tayport just received international clearance on Friday. The newcomer was relatively untroubled as the home defence coped relatively comfortably with Lochee's attacking threat. There weren't a lot of scoring chances and ironically the winning goal on 32 minutes could have been more described as a half chance. Stefan Elvin seized on a knock-down in a busy penalty box and smashed home a fierce shot in off a post from 15 yards. The same player almost doubled his tally on the stroke of half time with a shot which grazed the bar.

With Lochee pushing up towards the end in an attempt to salvage something from the game, they were left exposed at the back but Tayport failed to cash in. Lochee's misery was complete when Steel received his marching orders in the dying minutes.



Welcome to Tayport, Nathaniel



19 year old **Nathaniel Nwosu** made his Tayport debut last Saturday v Lochee United and here we reproduce the gist of an article from **November 2022**

It's pretty unheard of for a 16-year-old to be a full international for his country. It's even rarer for a goalkeeper of that age to already have a senior cap to his name.



Nathaniel Nwosu won't be a name that many football fans will be familiar with but he's emerging as one of the most promising goalkeepers in the whole of Africa, having made his senior international debut for Nigeria earlier this month. Nwosu came off the bench for the final 13 minutes of Nigeria's 2-0 international friendly defeat to Costa Rica on 10 November, keeping the Central Americans at bay in his time on the pitch ahead of them jetting off to Qatar for the World Cup.

When [head coach] Salisu Yusuf opted to send Nwosu off the bench to replace Kayode Bankole, he was 16 years and 10 months old, an unprecedented age for a goalkeeper to get a shot at a senior international cap. Before his call-up to the Nigeria senior side to play that game against Costa Rica, Nwosu was regularly playing for his country's Under-20s – still an incredible achievement for his tender age and the fact he's yet to join a professional club.

Canniepairt visitors could well see a change in the streetscape as they make their way down Nelson Street. The CO-OP supermarket could be moving. The COOP has applied to relocate to the old Picture House in Queen Street. The Picture House opened in 1931 and showed its last film in 1967.
