## THE CHAIRMAN...

Good afternoon to all. Kirrie Thistle provide todays opposition for this League Cup sectional game and. I'd like to take this opportunity to welcome their players and officials to Tayport. May I also welcome our fans to the Canniepairt.



It's been a difficult period for us this past couple of weeks, a home mid-week 0-0 draw versus Carnoustie wasn't in the script. Unfortunately, I wasn't in attendance but by all accounts it was a fairly flat game with very few scoring opportunities. Our keeper had little or nothing to contend with, while their keeper made a couple very good stops.

That result was followed with another poor result in our final league game, losing 3-0 at Broughty. Again I was missing in action on a Turkish jaunt. Seemingly our first half performance was okay, but we were second best after the interval. The early sending off of Jamie Crowe compounded a poor 45 minutes and we deservedly lost the game.

Despite my early morning return from holiday, I did manage make the North End cup game. To be honest, our opponents completely dominated possession and were well worthy of their 3-0 victory, the only threat we posed was from set pieces and long throws.

So, with our league season at an end, how have we done? From my position as the club chairman, I'm very pleased with our progress. Last season we finished 9<sup>th</sup>, losing a lot of points against sides who finished below us in the division. This time around, that hasn't been the case. Our defeats all came from the three sides who finished above us. Continuous improvement will do me. That won't be easy with the clear financial gap that exists between us and them but nothing is impossible.

This afternoon's encounter against Kirrie is basically a must win game for us if we have any chance of continuing in this league cup. A victory today and a win at Letham next Saturday would hopefully see us make the semi-final stage. But one step at a time. Our opponents had a good win over Letham last weekend and our players should know that, if we're to succeed this afternoon, we must earn it.

# TAYPORT V KIRRIE THISTLE BALMUIR SHEDS LEAGUE CUP



Top 10 Section B Game 3/4

We welcome Kirrie Thistle to Tayport this afternoon for what is our penultimate Balmuir Sheds League Cup (Top Section) tie and our final home game of the season.

Well, after Wednesday's results, we know what we have to do in order to have a chance of the runners-up spot in the section and therefore a place in the semi-final. Quite simple. We have to convincingly defeat Kirrie today and also Letham in Perth next week... and that's all on the assumption that Kirrie lose to North End next Saturday. A win or a draw for Kirrie today will take them into the semi-final with a game to still to play

Since our most recent meeting with Kirrie, our 3-1 win on Canniepairt in the first of the clubs' nine second phase matches, today's visitors have had a disappointing time in the league. A 2-0 win over Carnoustie Panmure was their solitary win in the midst of eight Top 10 section defeats.

However, the League Cup has seen a resurgence of form for Thistle with successive home wins over Letham and Carnoustie without former Tayport goalkeeper Jack Shaw losing a goal.

We maybe should not be surprised, however, as it should be noted that the scorelines in our three second phase defeats against the League's top 3, North End, Broughty Athletic and Downfield, in terms of the score, were virtually in line with Kirrie's defeats against the same opposition. This, and their current form, suggests that we will have our work cut out this afternoon.

Tayport have lost nine games this season... and five of those defeats have been by North End. We rarely threatened the Dokens in the most recent encounter last week, so the manager will be anxious to improve on that performance today.

With a number of players struggling with injury, the pool will be stretched but nevertheless, we will be looking to end our home season on a positive note.

#### PAUL BERG of TAYPORT FC WALKING FOOTBALL CLUB REPORTS...

April was a busy month for the Walking Football section.

On Sunday the 6th, both teams were in action in over 50s league games. Playing 3 games each, both the Championship and Conference sides finished the day undefeated. Well, to be honest we didn't win any either, all our six games finished drawn!

The Reds, in the Championship, drew 1-1 with Dunfermline, 1-1 with Dundee, and 0-0 with HIbs and we sit 4th in the league.

The Whites, in the Conference, drew 1-1 with Fort William, 1-1 with Forfar North, and 2-2 with Letham. They sit 5th in the league.

We now have a league break until August.

However, on Sunday **May 25th**, we have a team playing in the inaugural **Dunferm-line WF Tournament**, being held at Pitreavie Sports Centre.

Each squad must include 2 players over 70 years old, and no more than 2 players in their 50s. The rest of the squad must be in their 60s.

Then on Saturday June 7th, we have a team entered in the over 60s section of the Walking Football Scotland Scotlish Cup & Festival, sponsored by Chest Heart & Stroke Scotland. This is being held at Glasgow Green Football Centre.

18 teams are competing in this age group, and there are initially 3 groups of 6. We have been drawn against Arbroath, Motherwell, Oriam, Saint Anthony's and Townhead Strollers!



On Saturday April 6th we held a hospitality event at the Canniepairt, which 18 of our members attended.

It was a great success, the food was excellent, plenty of drink and Tayport won 3-0, so it couldn't have been better!

It'll now be an annual event on the WF calendar.


